Life Reflections of Mr. Brian Conrad Williams

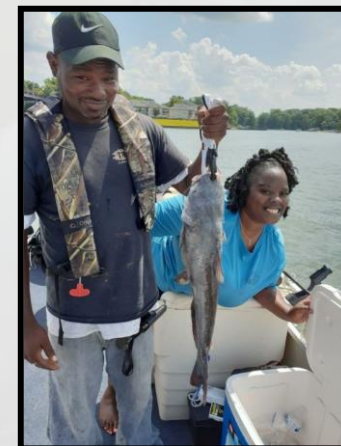
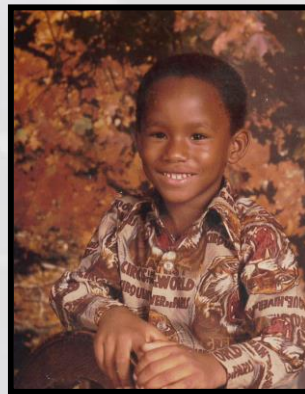
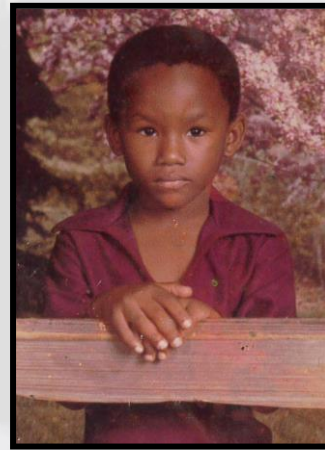
