Reverend Dr. Leander West

Leander West, Jr., son of the late Leander West, Jr. and Mary Pate West, was born on July 30, 1954 in Kinston, North Carolina, on Sunday January 30, 2022 he answered his call for eternal rest at his home in Blythewood, South Carolina. He was preceded in death by his sister Sarah Martin.

He attended the public schools of Lenoir County in Kinston, NC. Upon graduation in 1973, Leander West entered the United States Navy. After serving four years in the Navy, he answered his call into Christian ministry. In receipt of his calling, he attended Lenoir Community College and then transferred to Columbia Bible College in Columbia, South Carolina to further his studies and training. There he received a degree in Biblical Education and was ordained a Minister to preach the gospel.

In the act of helping fulfill the needs of the sick, Reverend West went on to receive a License Practical Nursing Degree from Midlands Technical College, Columbia, South Carolina. He was employed at Tucker Center and Midlands Regional Center, Columbia, South Carolina where he retired.

Reverend West was called to minister at Jerusalem Branch Baptist Church in Salley, South Carolina and ministered there for 13 years. Under his ministry many souls were saved. The church thrived under his leadership even under diverse circumstances. He assisted in the rebuilding of the church after it was burned down under unusual circumstances.

After many years of services at Jerusalem Branch Baptist Church under the leadership of the Holy Spirit he was lead/called to Mount Zion Baptist Church, Blythewood, South Carolina in June 1990 where he was later installed as the tenth Pastor on October 21, 1990. After 30 years of service at Mount Zion, Pastor West retired in July 2020. On May 2, 2021, Pastor West was conferred the title "Pastor Emeritus" of Mount Zion Baptist Church.

Pastor West's ministry has assisted Mount Zion Baptist Church members and congregation in nurturing its Christian spirituality. Under his leadership, the church has grown. Honorary mentions include: Telephone Services, Weekly Bible Study, Counseling, Water Cooler, Pew and carpet replacements, Church by-laws and constitution, Junior Usher Board, Brotherhood, Youth Department, First Aide Society, Library, Recording System, Drum Set, Bible Display Case, Lectern, Sunday Youth Ministry and Noon Day Bible Study. Pastor West strives on his Christian faith to enhance not only the growth of membership within the church but its Christian spirituality as well.

Reverend West previously served as immediate moderator of the Cedar Branch Association, Wagner-Salley, South Carolina and as president of the Congress of Christian Education of the Gethsemane Baptist Association, Columbia, South Carolina.


