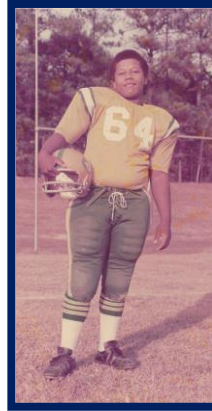
Ricky was employed by and retired from the South Carolina Department of Disabilities and Special Needs, after many years of dedicated service.
