Mr. WT Williams

WT Williams, son of the late LM Williams and Nonie Mae Williams, was born in Lincolnton, Georgia, on March 18, 1957. He departed this life on Saturday, February 26, 2022 at Lexington Medical Center, surrounded by his loving family.

At an early age, he joined Prices Grove Baptist Church in Lincolnton, Georgia. WT attended Lincoln County High School and graduated in 1975. During his time at Lincoln County High, he excelled and lettered in 4 sports as team captain- football, basketball, baseball, and track. He was known as one of the best. WT was the first black athlete to earn a full scholarship in football from Lincoln County High. He then attended the University of South Carolina, where he played football for 4 years.

He decided to make his home in Columbia, SC, where he pursued a career in law enforcement and later obtained his CDL to drive semi-trucks. His love for trucking led him to establish WT Trucking, where he was the owner and operator. He was a master griller, enjoyed fishing, and being around family and friends.

WT was pre-deceased by his father, LM Williams and brother, Jerome Williams.

He leaves to cherish fond memories: his wife of more than 23 years, Beverly Williams; two daughters, O'Shecia Wynn of Augusta, GA and Ebony Williams of Columbia, SC; his mother, Nonie Mae Williams of Lincolnton, GA; two brothers, Charlie Frank and Alphonso Williams of Lincolnton, GA; sisters-in-law, Belinda (James) Brittingham of Columbia, SC and Vivian (Charles) Lott of Union, SC; three grandchildren, Bekendrianna, Ryjon, and Jamaria Wynn all of Augusta, GA; a great-grandson, Omaré James of Augusta, GA; a goddaughter, Alisia Bowser Acree of Waldorf Maryland; a host of aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
