Obituary

Kenneth Nathan Moyd, son of the late James Nathan Moyd and Eaife Gadson Moyd, was born August 19, 1958, in Kings County Hospital, Brooklyn, New York. He departed this life on April 25, 2022, at Agape Lowcountry Hospice House, in Summerville, SC.
