

## Obituary

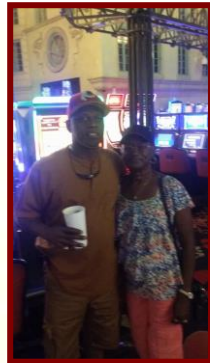


