Mr. Ryan Roosevelt Rowe

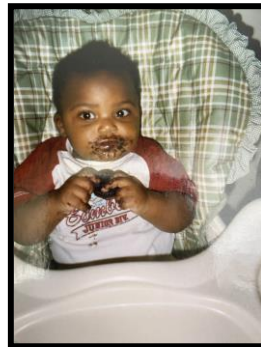
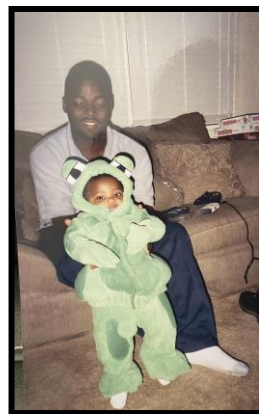
