Obituary

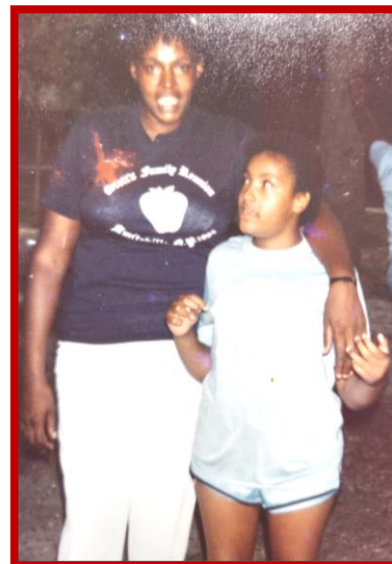
