Obituary of Mrs. Gwendell Jones Fogg

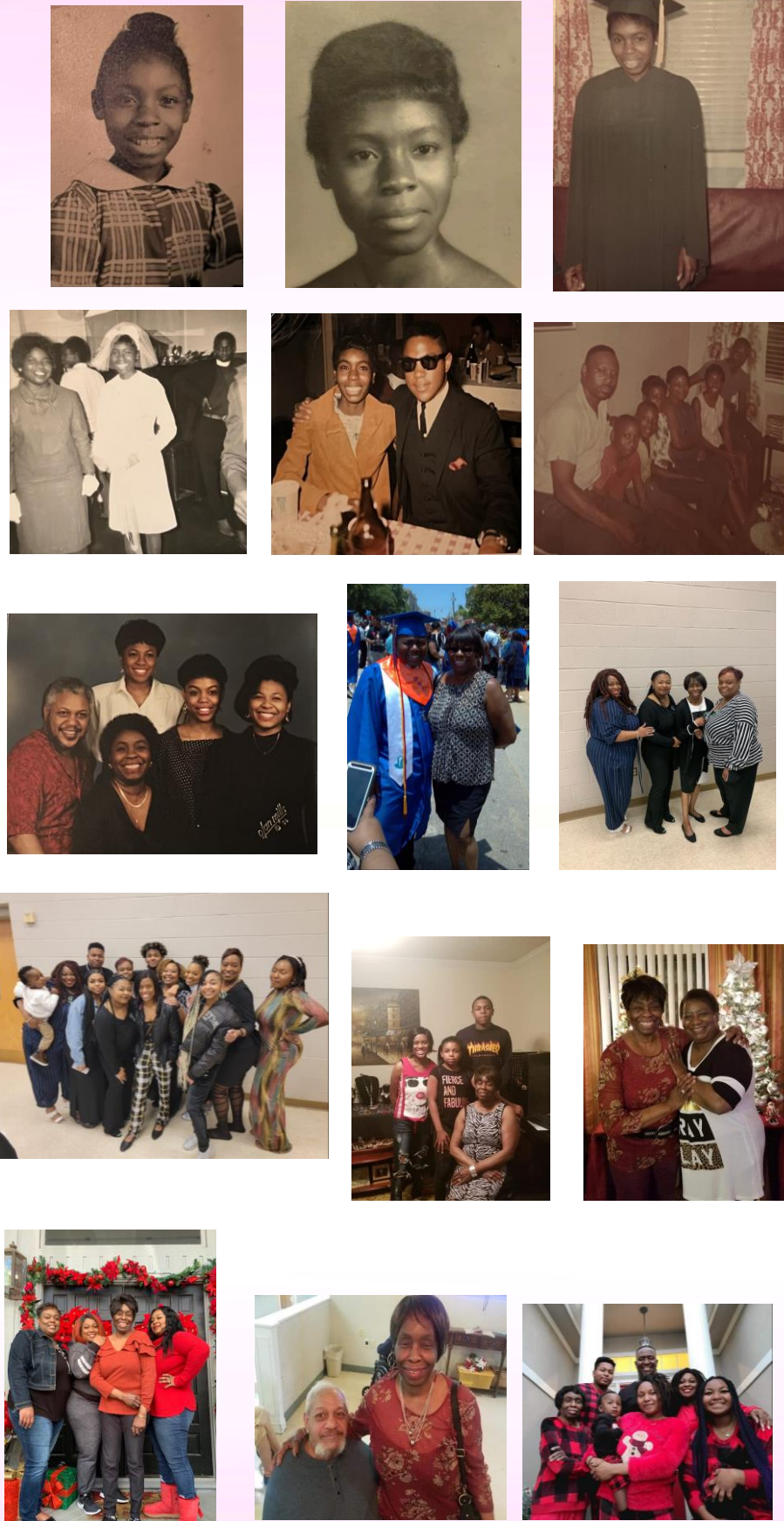
