She attended the public schools of Richland County, South Carolina.

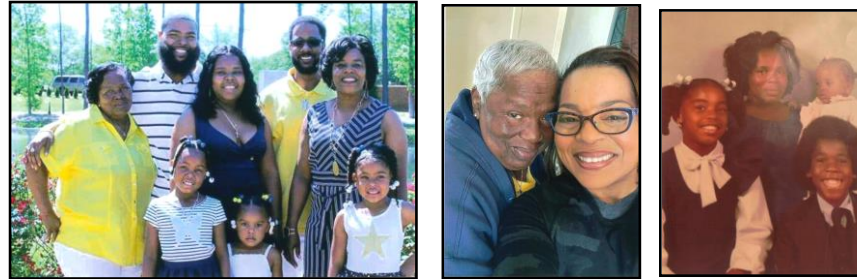
