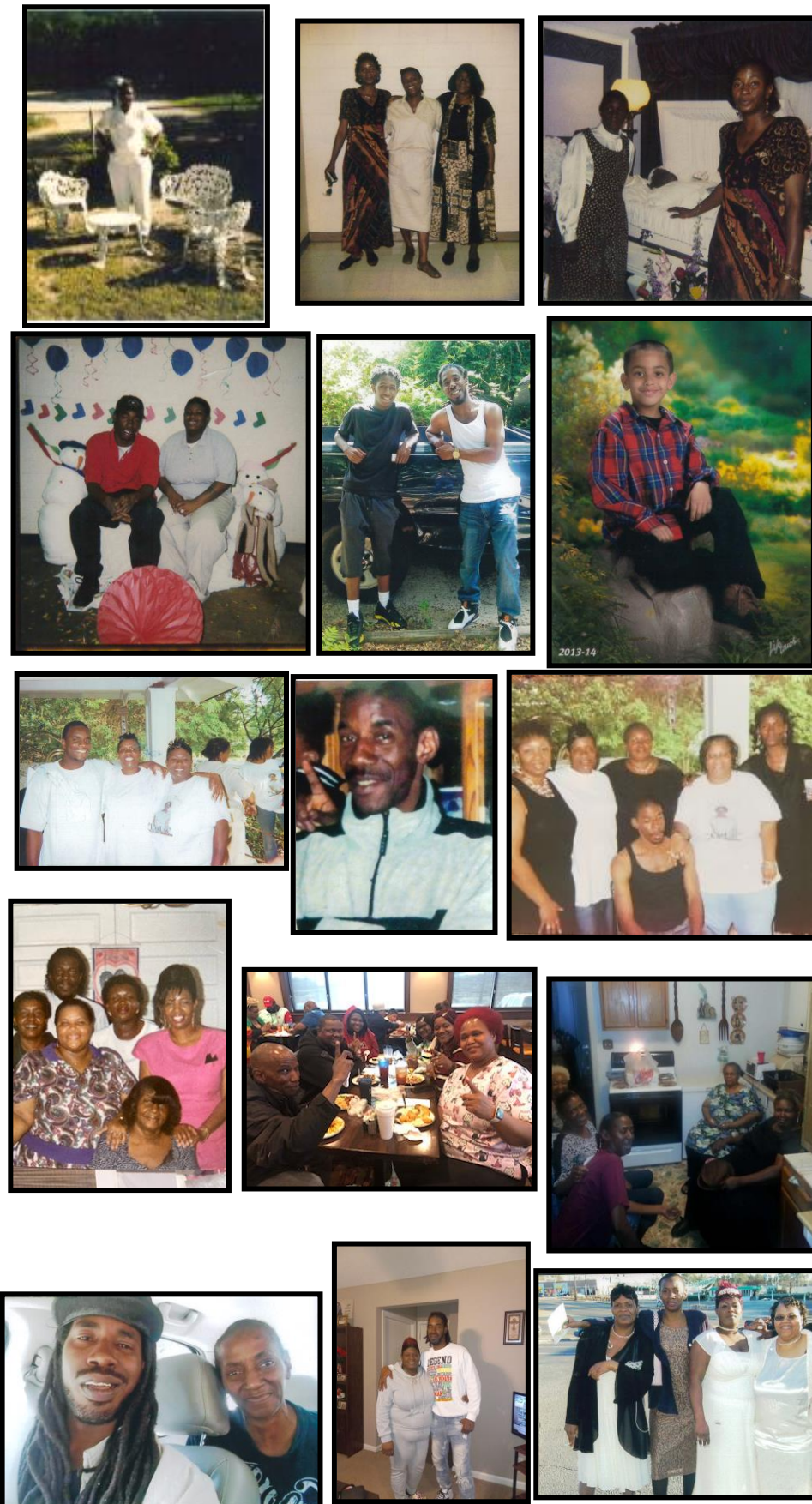
Isla was educated in the public schools of Richland County, South Carolina. She enjoyed spending time with her family, going to the movies, and watching her favorite TV shows.
