On The Wings of Prayer

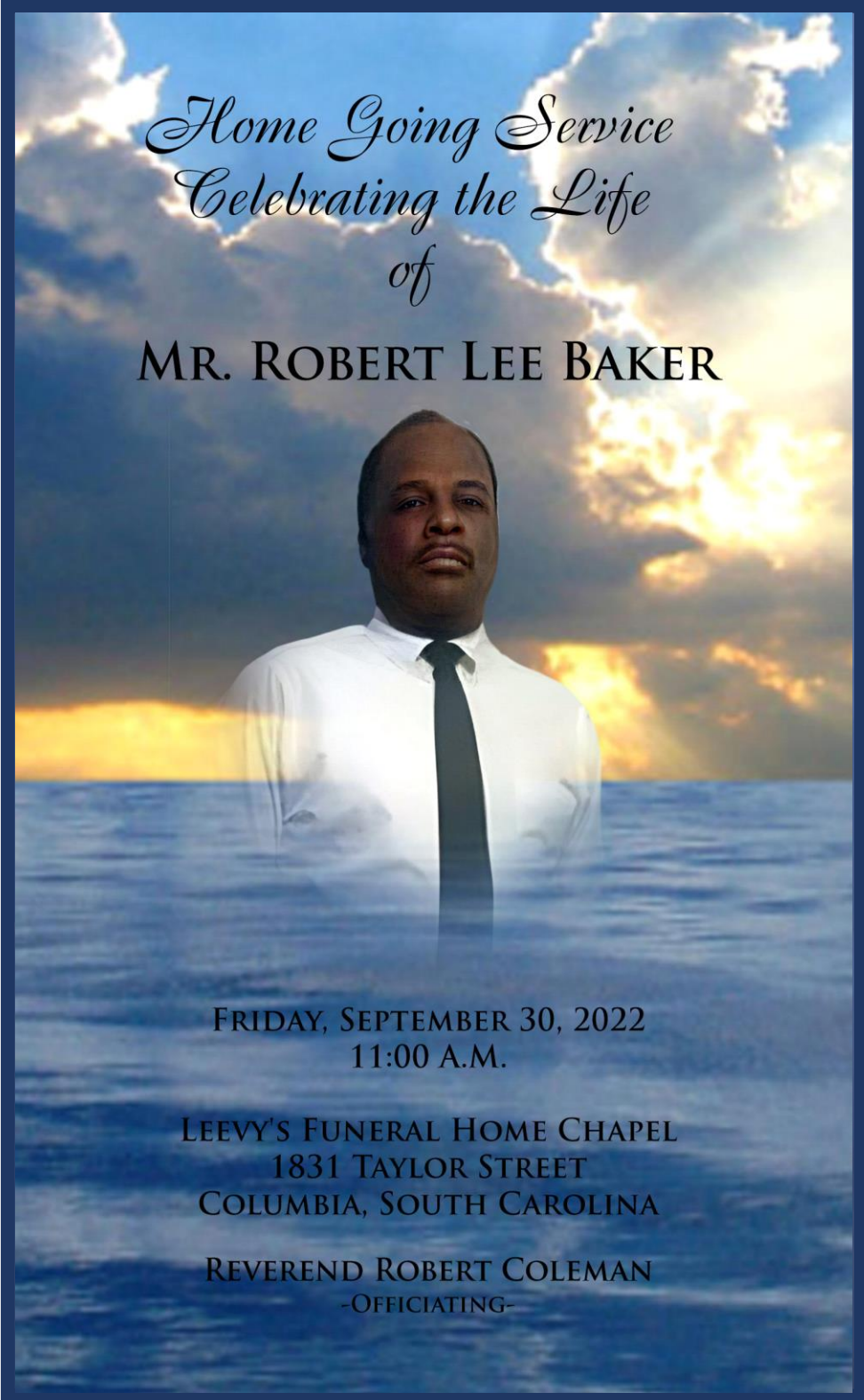
*Just close your eyes and open you heart
