For your time has come.*

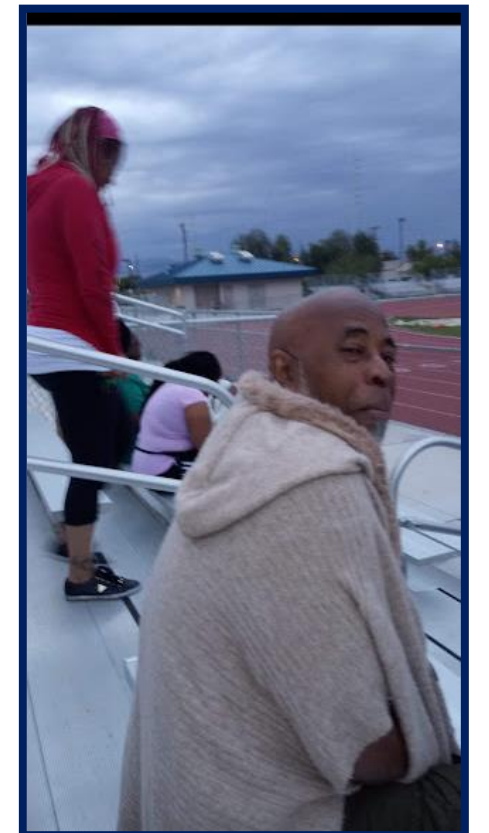
*Words unspoken – I am sure everybody has some.

In time of need.*

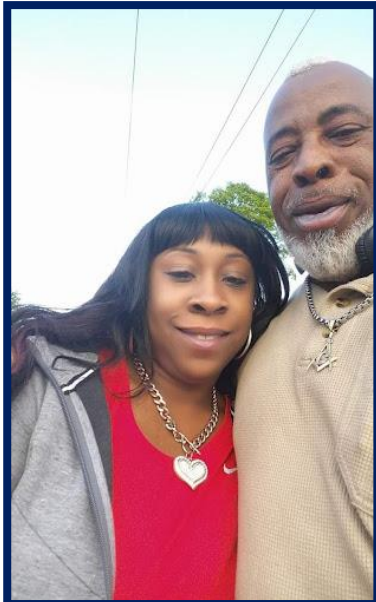
