She attended Zion Canaan Baptist Church, in Columbia, South Carolina with her husband.

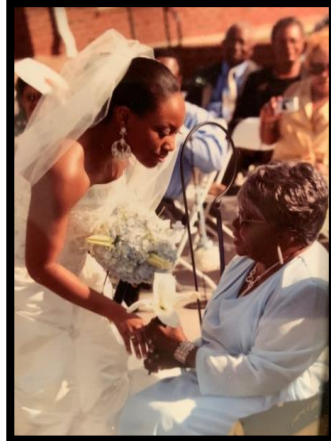
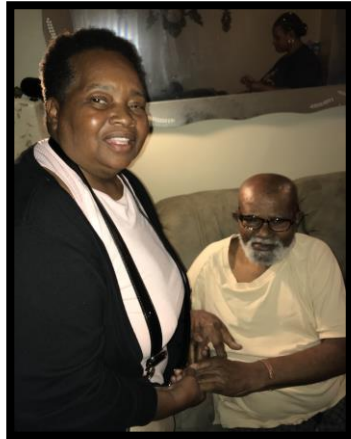

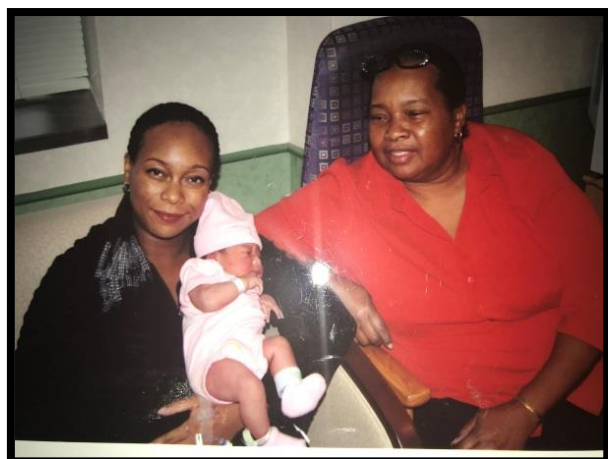
