

Obituary

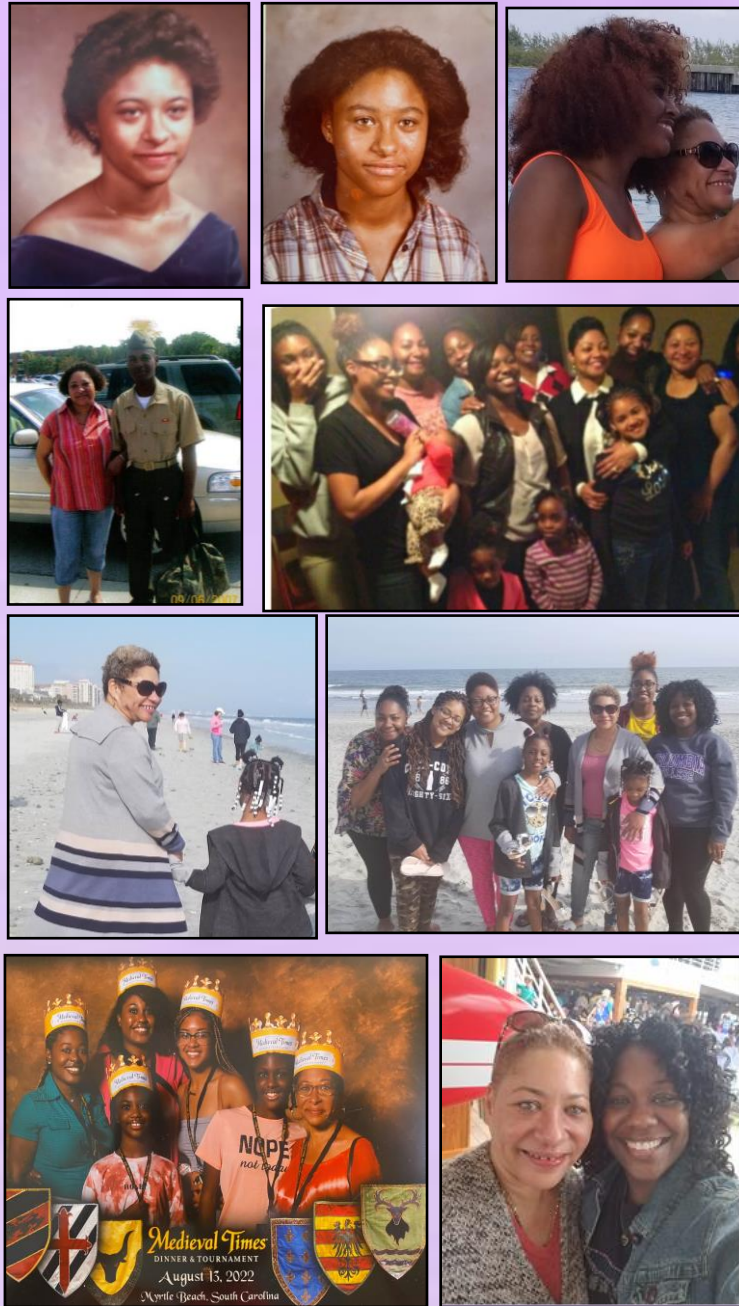
