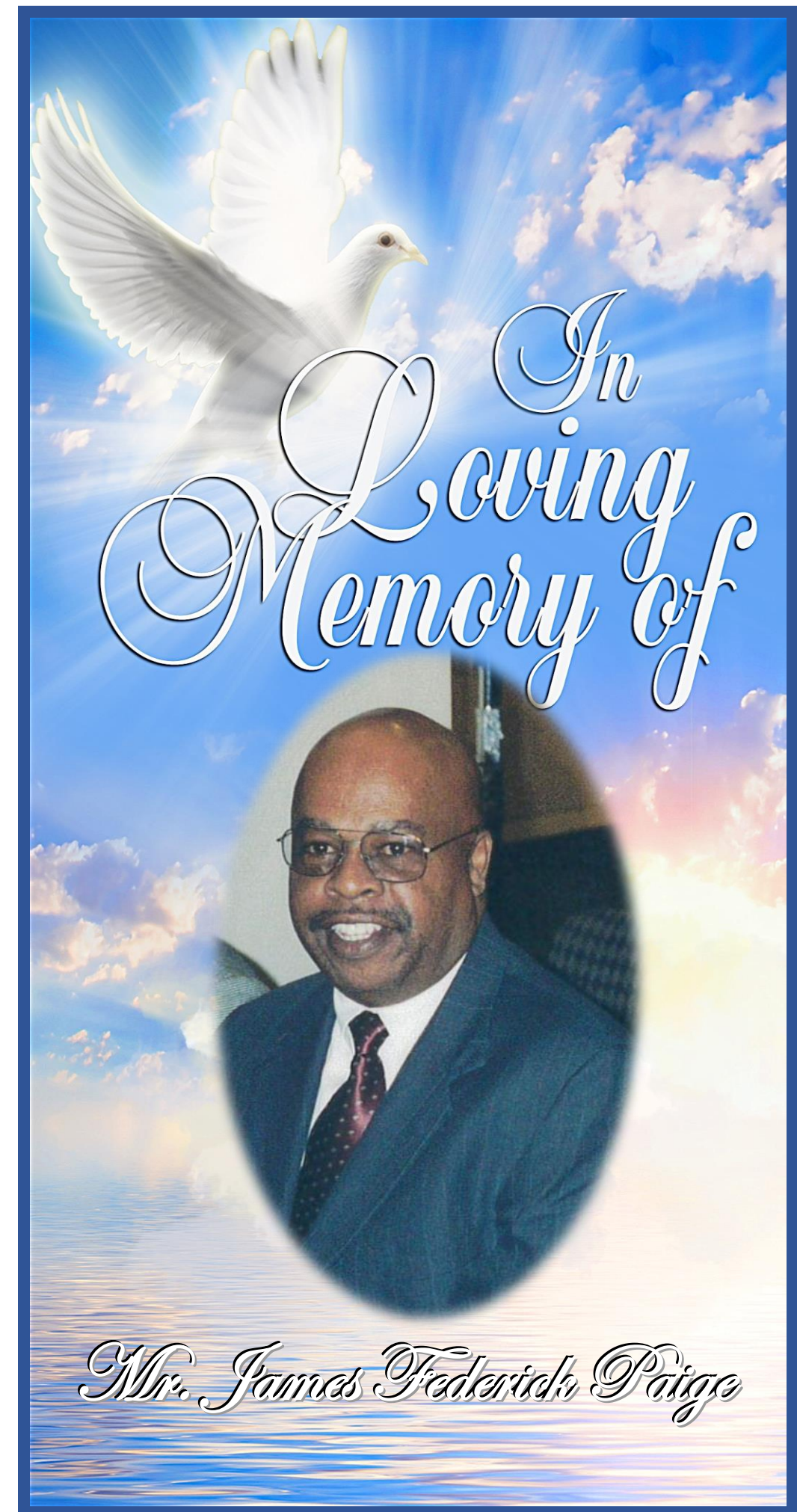

# Obituary

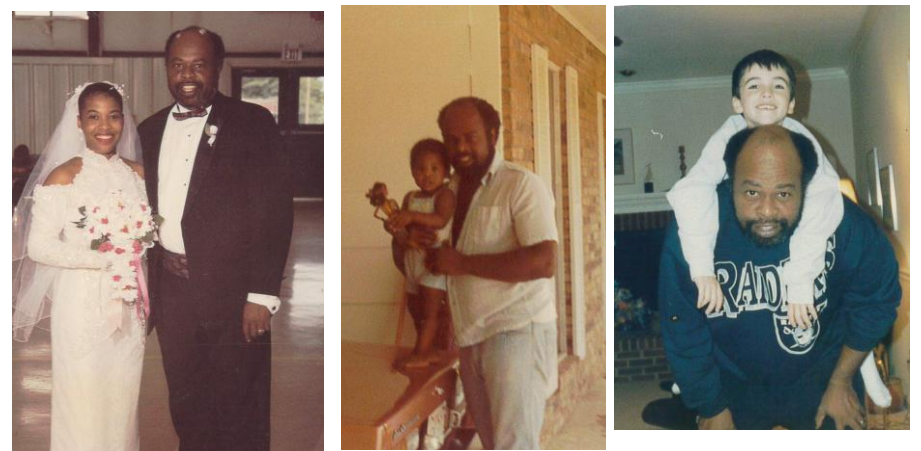
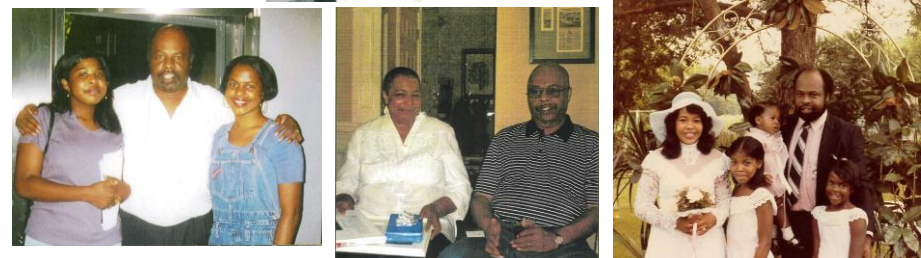
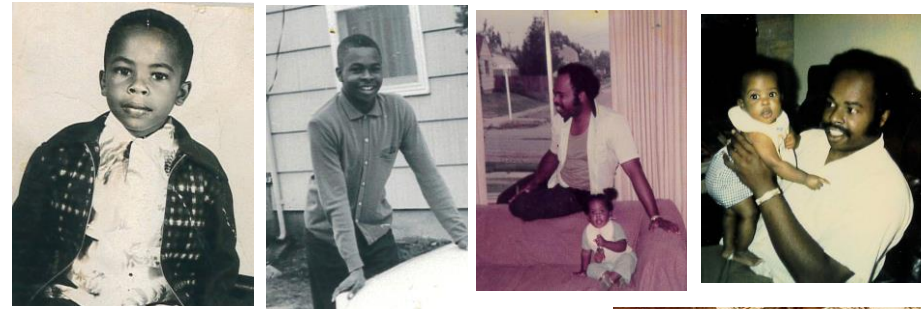
