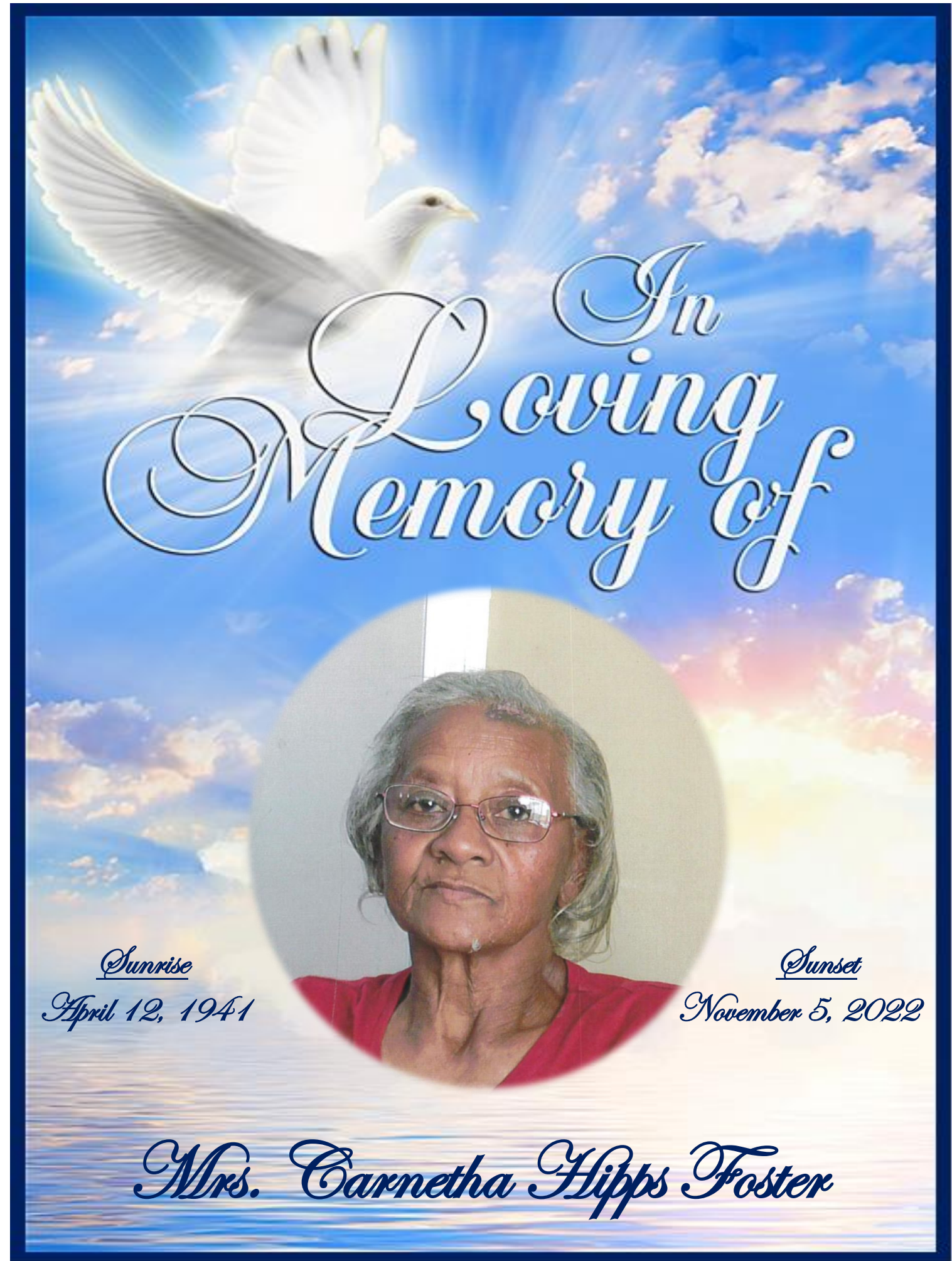

and always will do too.

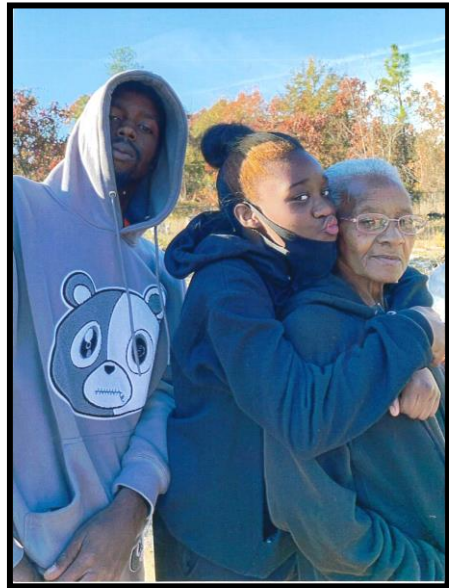
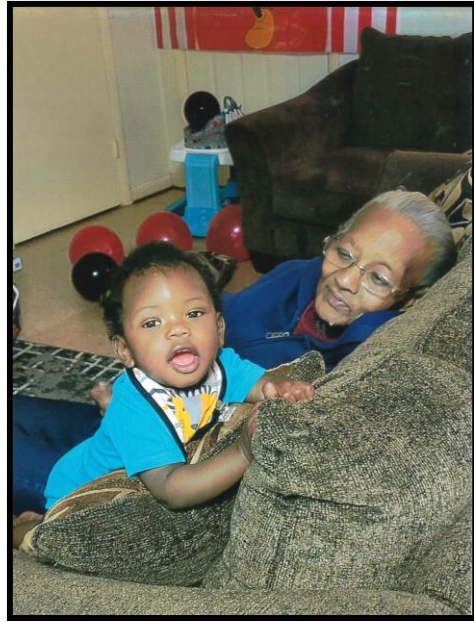
