Nyesha Reneé Darden, affectionately known as "Nye," was born on July 2, 1983, in New Rochelle, NY to Melvin L. Darden, Jr. and Tammy G. Jones. She was raised and received her education through the New Rochelle Public School system, graduating from New Rochelle High School, in the year 2000. In 2002, she received an Associate's Degree in Business Administration, from Westchester Community College. She also earned a Nurse's Aide certification in 2008, from Midlands Technical College in Columbia, SC.

In 2008, Nyesha relocated to Columbia, SC where she would raise her three beautiful children – Anayah (2005), Malakhi (2015), and Marcianna (2019).
