Mr. Quentin Odell Gantt was born October 18, 1972, in Columbia, South Carolina. He was the youngest child of Mr. Raymond Odell Gantt and the late Bonnie Stine Dingle Gantt. He departed this life on Thursday, December 1, 2022.

Mr. Gantt was educated in the public schools of Richland County, South Carolina, and graduated from Spring Valley High School, class of 1990. Quentin began his working career as a bag boy at Piggly Wiggly Grocery store, in Southeast Columbia. After leaving Piggly Wiggly, he was employed at Otis Spunkmeyer manufacturing plant, in West Columbia, South Carolina for several years. He was later employed at Westinghouse Electric, in Hopkins, South Carolina for 17 years. He retired in 2018.

Mr. Gantt was an avid bowler and sports fan. He was a lifetime fan of the South Carolina Gamecocks, Atlanta Braves, and Dallas Cowboys.

Mr. Gantt's family was his most prized accomplishment.
