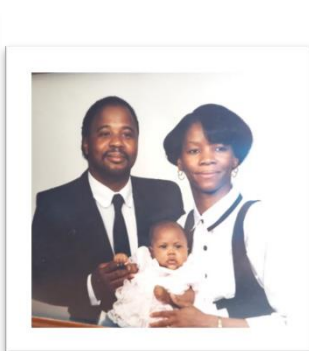
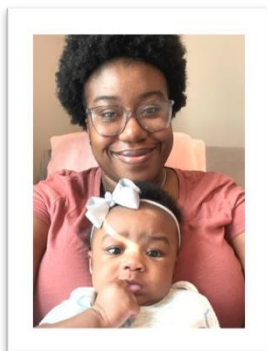

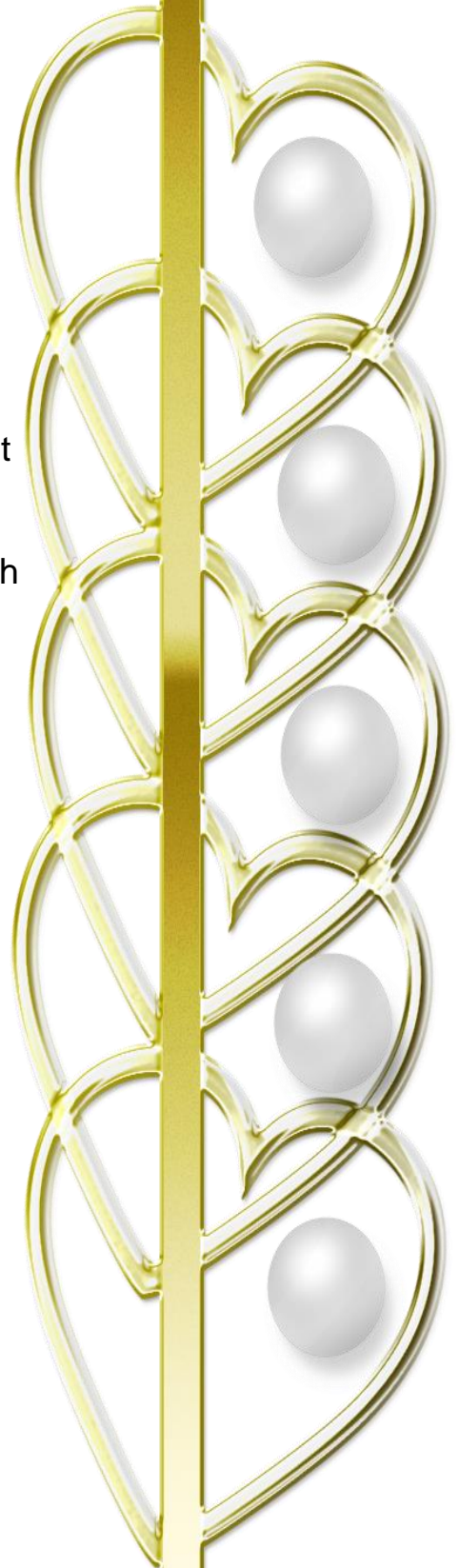


Our Mom
