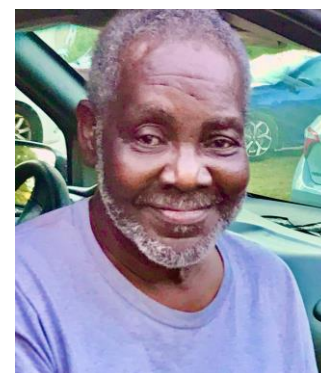
Fagner was a 1970 graduate of Lower Richland High School. He was a retired Tech. Sergeant in the United States Air Force, where he served for 22 years.
