



Reflections of the Life Mrs. Mardine Patterson Walker

Mrs. Mardine "Dina" Walker was born on October 8, 1937, to the late Charlie Patterson and Rosa Palmer Patterson, in Blythewood, South Carolina. She passed away peacefully on January 12, 2023, at 11:51 a.m., surrounded by her loved ones at the Mayo Hospital in Jacksonville, Florida.

Mardine was educated in the public schools of Richland County, South Carolina, and graduated from Bethel - Hanberry High School.

She was employed by the Department of Mental Health for 20 years. After leaving, she operated an in-home family daycare. Many of the families and children she cared for continued to maintain close relationships with her over the years.

Mardine was baptized early, and was a faithful member of Bethel Baptist Church, in Blythewood, South Carolina. During her marriage, she and her husband joined Round Top Baptist Church, where she spent many years serving on the Usher Board and the Jubilee choir. After her husband passed, she rejoined her childhood church, Bethel Baptist.


