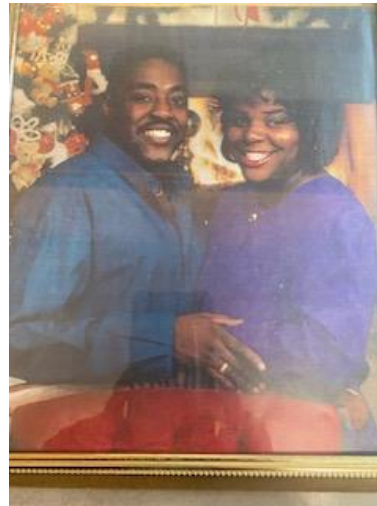
She committed her life to her Lord and Savior in 1994, and was a faithful member of Blessed Hope Ana Baptist Church.
