

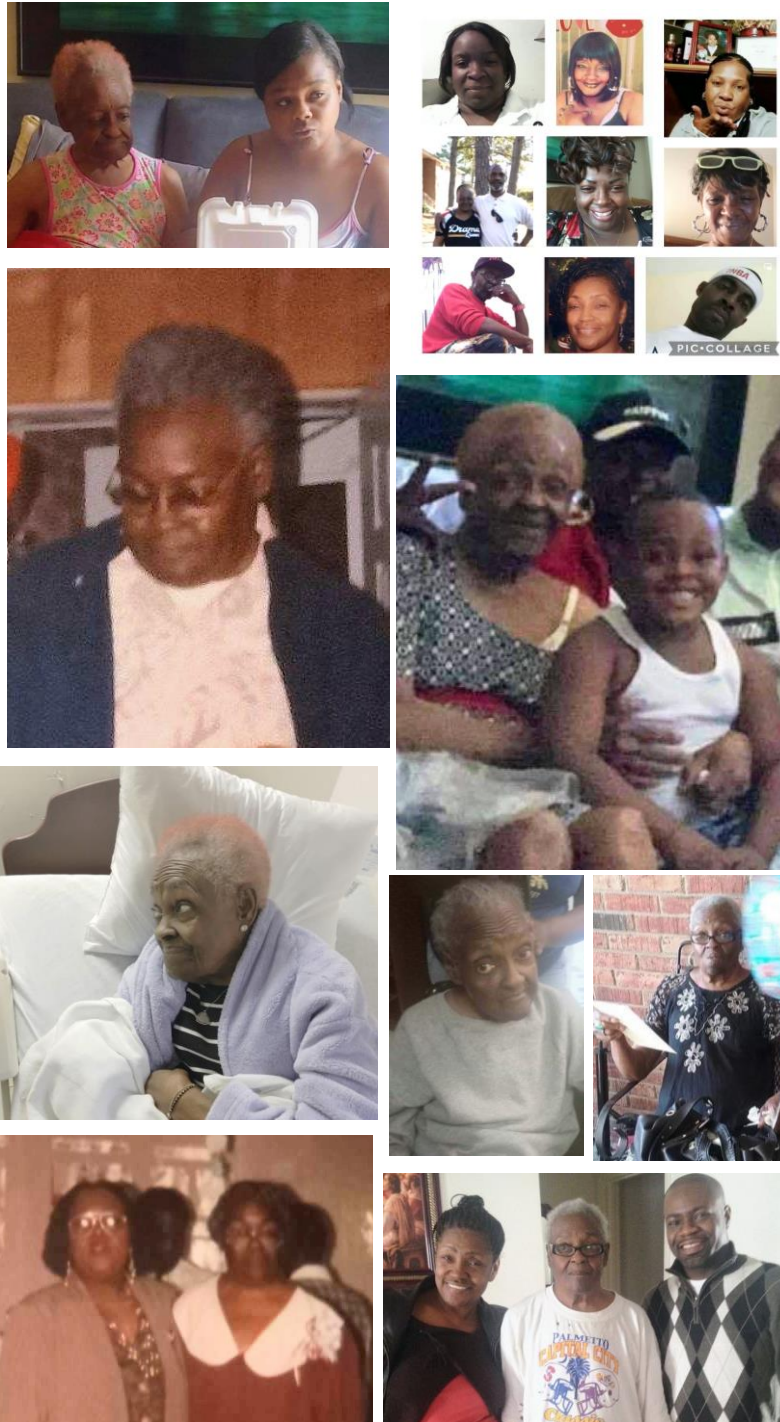
*Obituary*
