Mr. Pearson was educated in the public schools of Sumter County, South Carolina. He was a graduate of Manchester High School, in Pinewood, South Carolina.

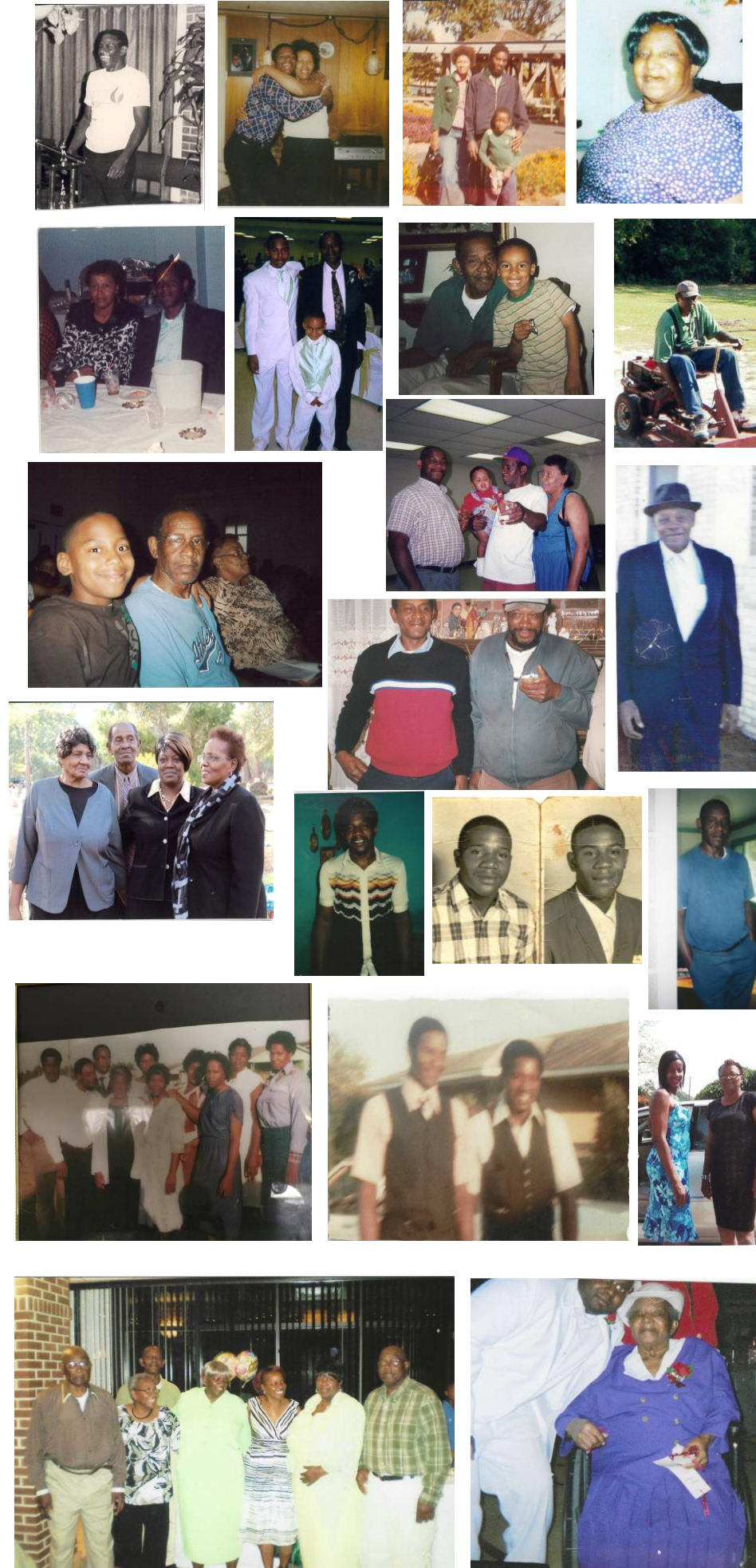
He believed in hardwork and taking care of his family. He was employed with Hobart later Whirlpool for over twenty years. He later retired from Providence Hopsital, Northeast.
