Deaconess Dellia Johnson Mosley-Baxter, the beloved wife of Deacon Tommy L. Baxter went home to be with the Lord Wednesday, May 17, 2023. She was the daughter of the late Glenmore Johnson and the late Annie Lowman Johnson of Hopkins, South Carolina.

Deaconess Mosley-Baxter attended the public schools of Richland County and graduated from Hopkins High School, class of 1964. She furthered her education at Benedict College and received her Bachelor of Arts degree in English in May 1968. While at Benedict, she joined Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc.
