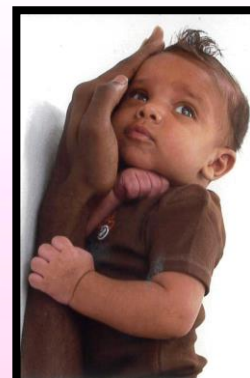
Veve was baptized at an early age, confessing Christ at Market Street Baptist Church in Galveston, Texas, under the leadership of Pastor James Thomas.
