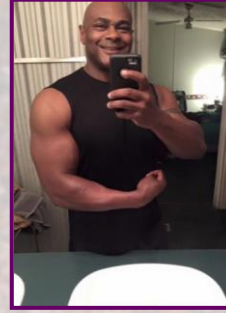
A Time To Leisure...
