Obituary

Jacqueline was educated in the public schools of Richland County, South Carolina. She was a 1986 graduate of Eau Claire High School. After high school, she attended Rutledge College, where she earned her certification as a Certified Nursing Assistant.

Ms. Penn loved sharing her personal testimonies, reading biblical scriptures, singing spiritual songs, and putting smiles on the faces of others.
