"I feel my help coming on" – Rev. P.W. Wise

Around 3:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 22, 2023, with his devoted family by his side, Patrick took flight with the celestial angels and entered His Kingdom. Patrick William Wise was one of nine children born in Springfield, SC on December 24, 1951, to the late Ervin and Lila Mae Amiker Wise. He was preceded in death by two beloved siblings, Margie Hughey and Henry Wise. Growing up in a Christian household, he developed a love and sense of compassion for servant leadership. His leadership abilities were recognized at an early age and allowed him to become the first African American Student Body President of Wagner-Salley High School, in 1971.

At an early age, Wise was baptized at the Oakey Spring Baptist Church, in Springfield, SC. He was licensed and ordained in the ministry at the Piney Grove Baptist Church, in Perry, SC. He later joined the Jerusalem Branch Baptist Church in Salley, SC. Reverend Wise has pastored several churches throughout the state of South Carolina since 1978, including: Gospel Temple Baptist, Neese, SC; Springfield Baptist, Eureka, SC; Morris Creek Baptist, Winnsboro, SC; Mt. Zion Baptist, Chapin, SC; Bethel Baptist, Blythewood, SC; Mt. Zion Baptist, Eastover, SC; and retired as the Senior Pastor of Mt. Moriah Baptist, Camden, SC, after 23 years, in March 2023. A fervent communicator of God's Word, Pastor Wise is known for his practical and dynamic preaching style which helps people apply the timeless truths of Scripture to their everyday lives. Reverend Wise favorite scripture was Jeremiah 3:15.

Dr. Wise earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Benedict College, a master's degree from Cambridge College, and a doctorate degree from Southwest University. He also served in the US Army for four years. Wise taught in the public-school systems in Georgia and South Carolina. After successfully teaching at Dent Middle School, Columbia, SC for 19 years, he retired with 30 years of teaching experience.

Wise served in many capacities in the community. He has served as Vice Moderator of the Beaver Creek Baptist Association and Mt. Moriah Baptist Association, lifetime member of the Camden Kershaw Branch of the NAACP, board member of the Wise Education Foundation Inc. and a faithful supporter of the National Baptist Convention of America USA, Inc. In his spare time, he enjoyed traveling, bike riding, attending theater performances, eating chocolate chip cookies, and watching his favorite TV show, *Columbo*. He had a passion for reading and writing which has resulted in several publications.

He leaves to cherish fond memories to include: wife of 44 years, Mablean Evans, of Columbia, SC; one daughter, Patrice La'Sandra, of Columbia, SC; three sons, Patrick Jermaine Holley (Tiffany), of Columbia, SC; Dr. Derrick William, of Springfield, SC; and Jefferi Evans, of Charlotte, NC; grandchildren, Ty'Vare Blyther, Tyler Montgomery, Layla Montgomery, Jaleel Holley, Kameel Holley, Elijah Holley, and Maryah Wise; three brothers, Ervin Jr., of Springfield, SC; Joseph (Romelda), of Columbia, SC; and Danny (Gloria), of West Columbia, SC; four sisters, Mattie Louise Gadson-Childs, of Columbia, SC, Beatrice Phillips, of North, SC; Felicia Wise, of New York, NY, and Linda Ann Wise, of Wagener, SC; one uncle, Henry Clay Amiker, of Jacksonville, FL; one godson, Jordyn Evans, of Columbia, SC; one goddaughter, Lisa Brisby, of Columbia, SC; a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, beloved friends, and sons, and daughters in ministry.
