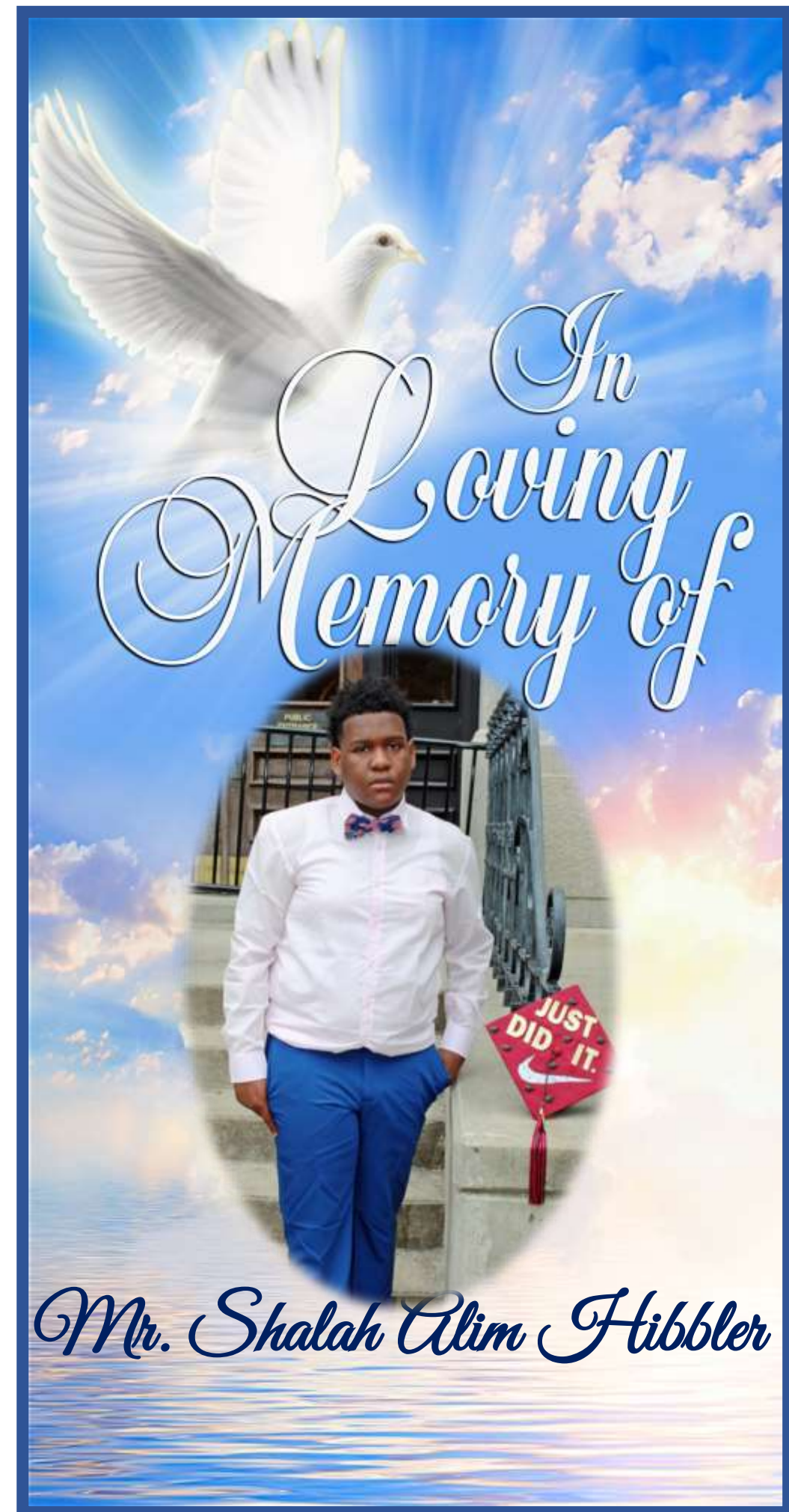

He was preceded in death by his paternal great-grandmother, Ruth Abdullah.

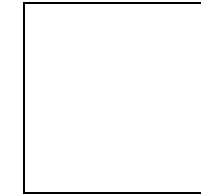
