

Reflections of the Life of SFC (Ret) Maurice Wise

SFC (Ret) Maurice Wise affectionally known by family and friends as "Sarge/Point/Big Reese," was born on February 13, 1952, in Detroit, Michigan, to the late Mr. Arthur Wise and Martha Jean Cox Wise. SFC (Ret) Maurice Wise departed this life on Friday, August 4, 2023. SFC (Ret) Maurice Wise graduated from Highland Park High, Class of 1970. After high school, he continued his education at and graduated from Highland Park Community College with an associates in business administration. SFC (Ret.)
