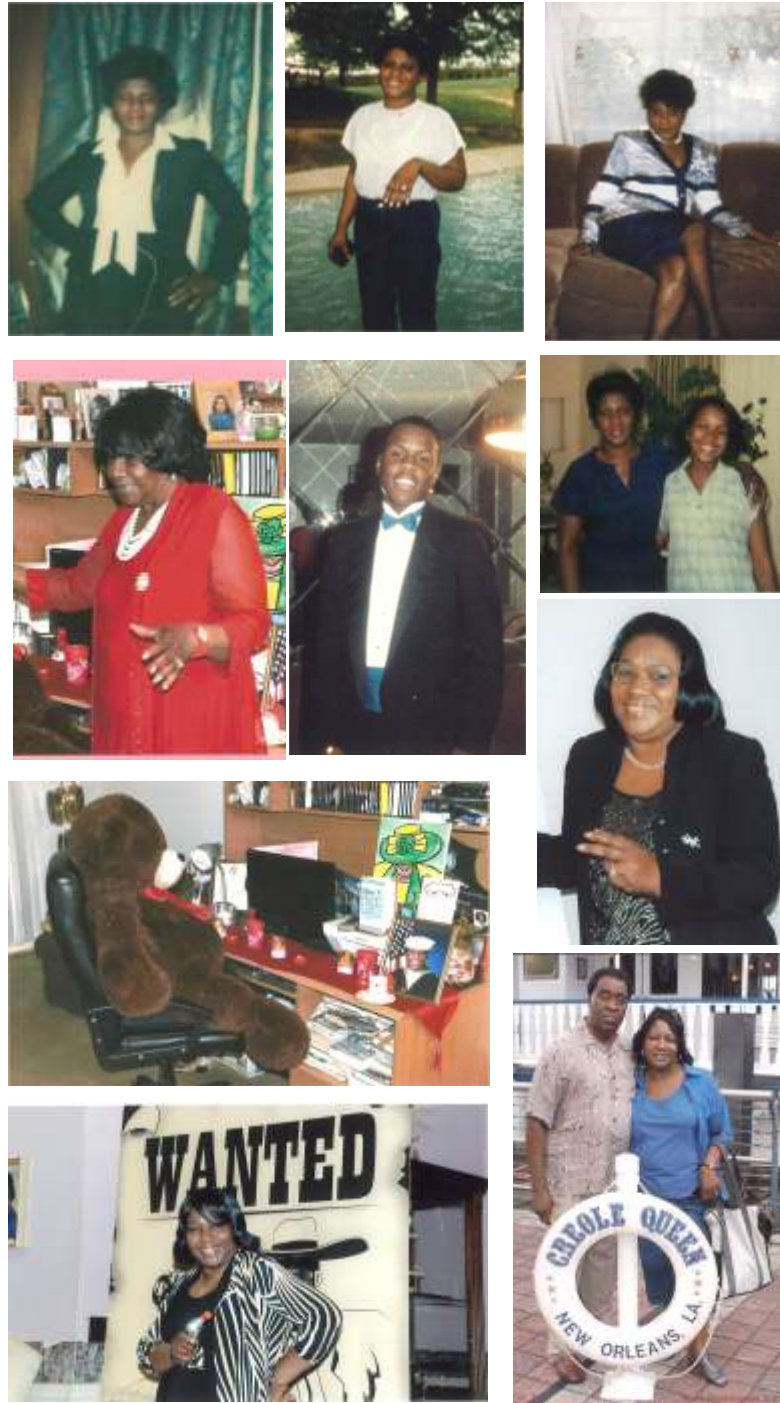
Mrs. Hall accepted Christ at an early age and was a member of Greater St. Luke Baptist Church.
