Mr. Nykeem Terrell Mills

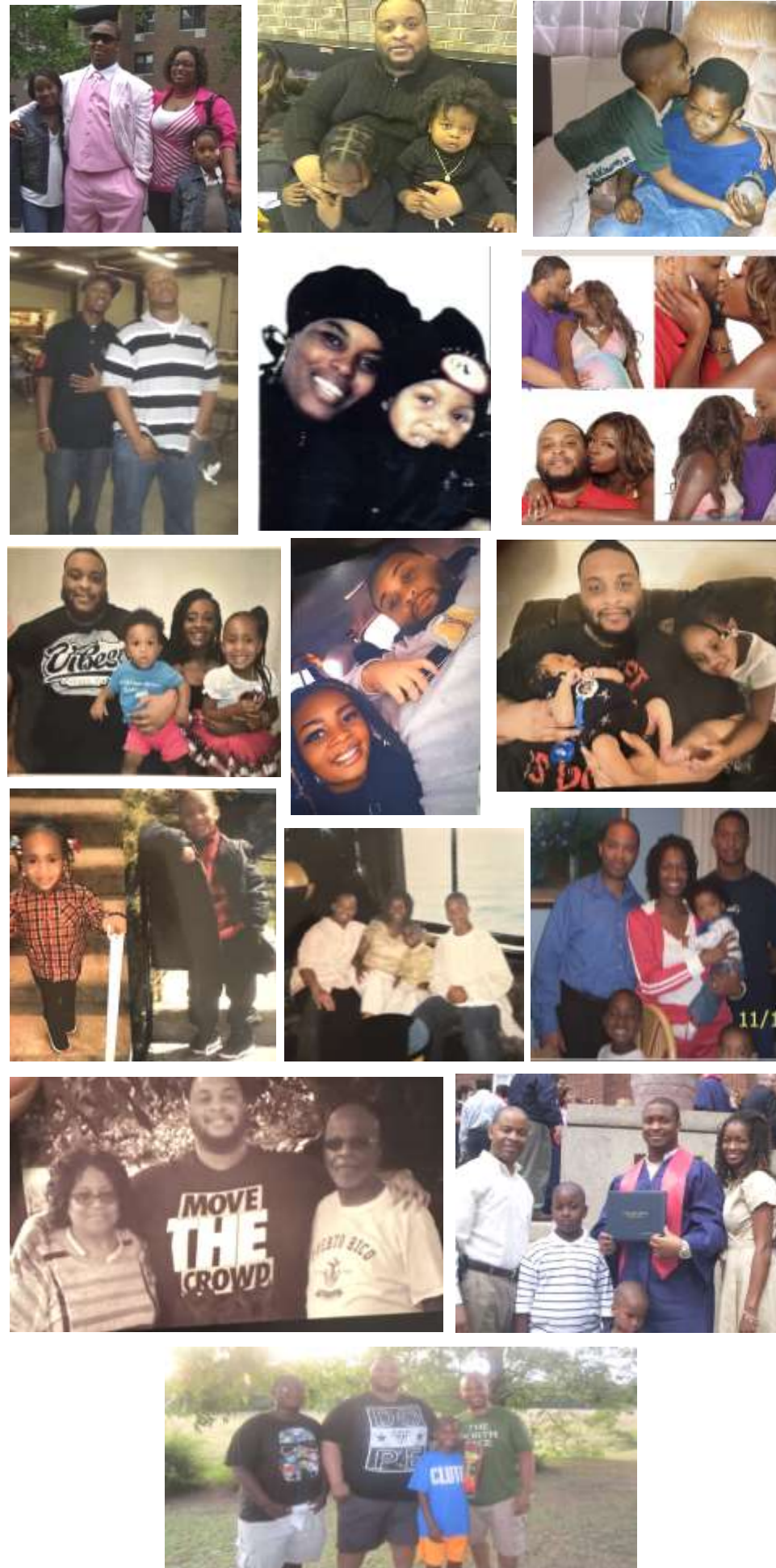
