Grover married the love of his life Sallie Mae Green, of Columbia, South Carolina. They were married for 68 glorious years. Their union was blessed with ten loving children.

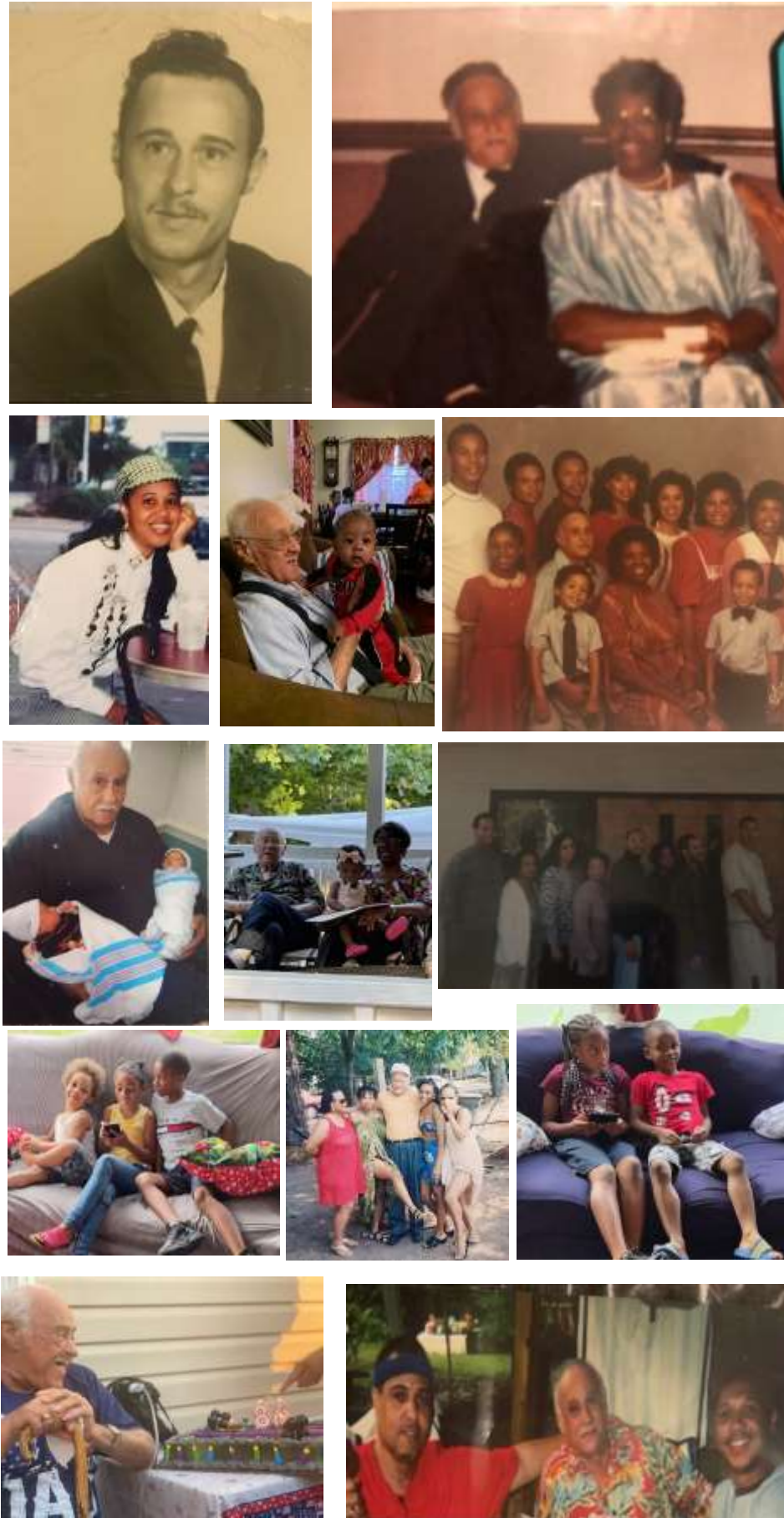
Grover was a member of the Church of Christ at Ames Road. He was a strong and exemplary family man who loved his family members dearly, those both far and near.
