# Obituary of Mr. Myles Brent Geter

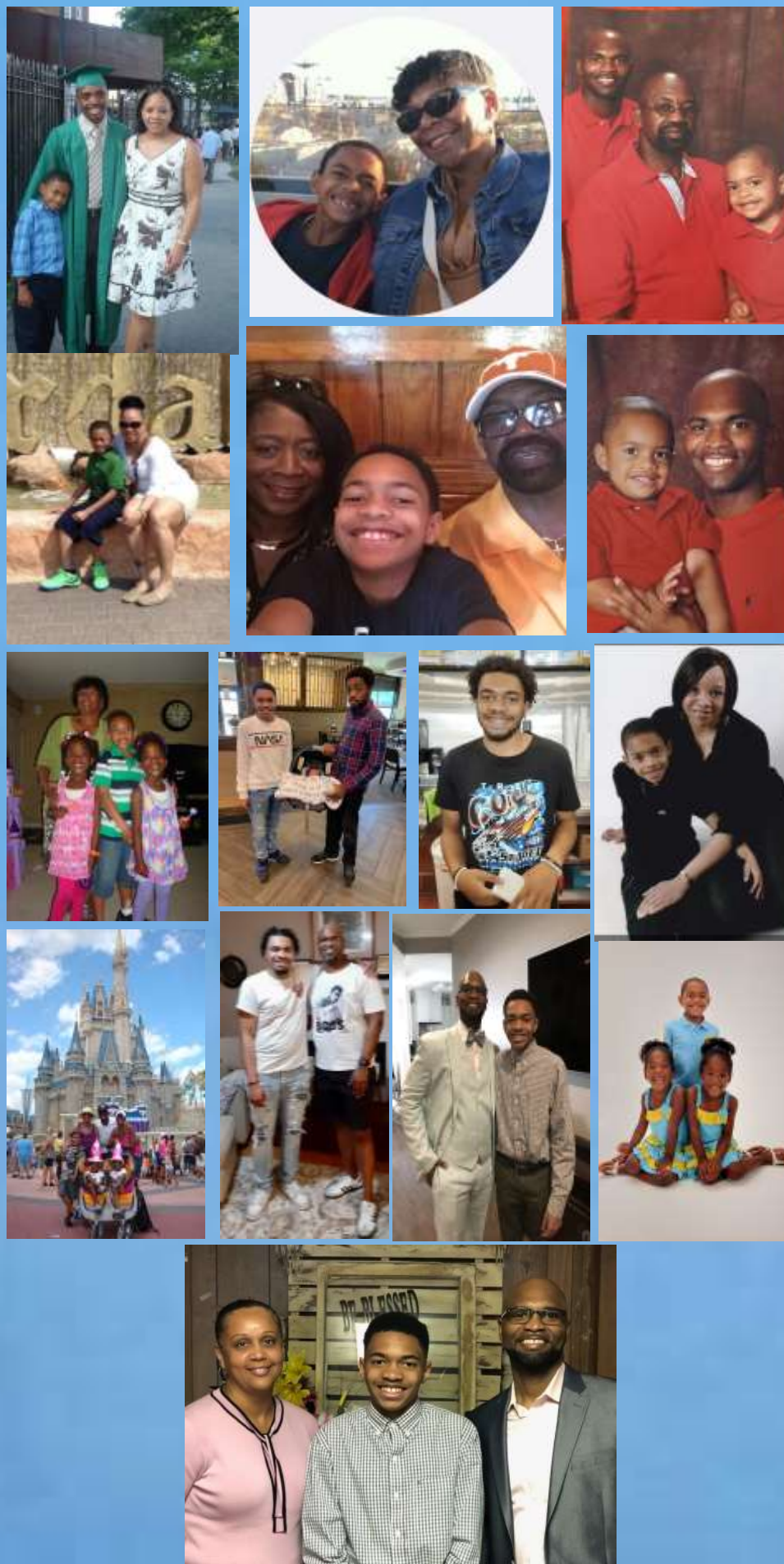
