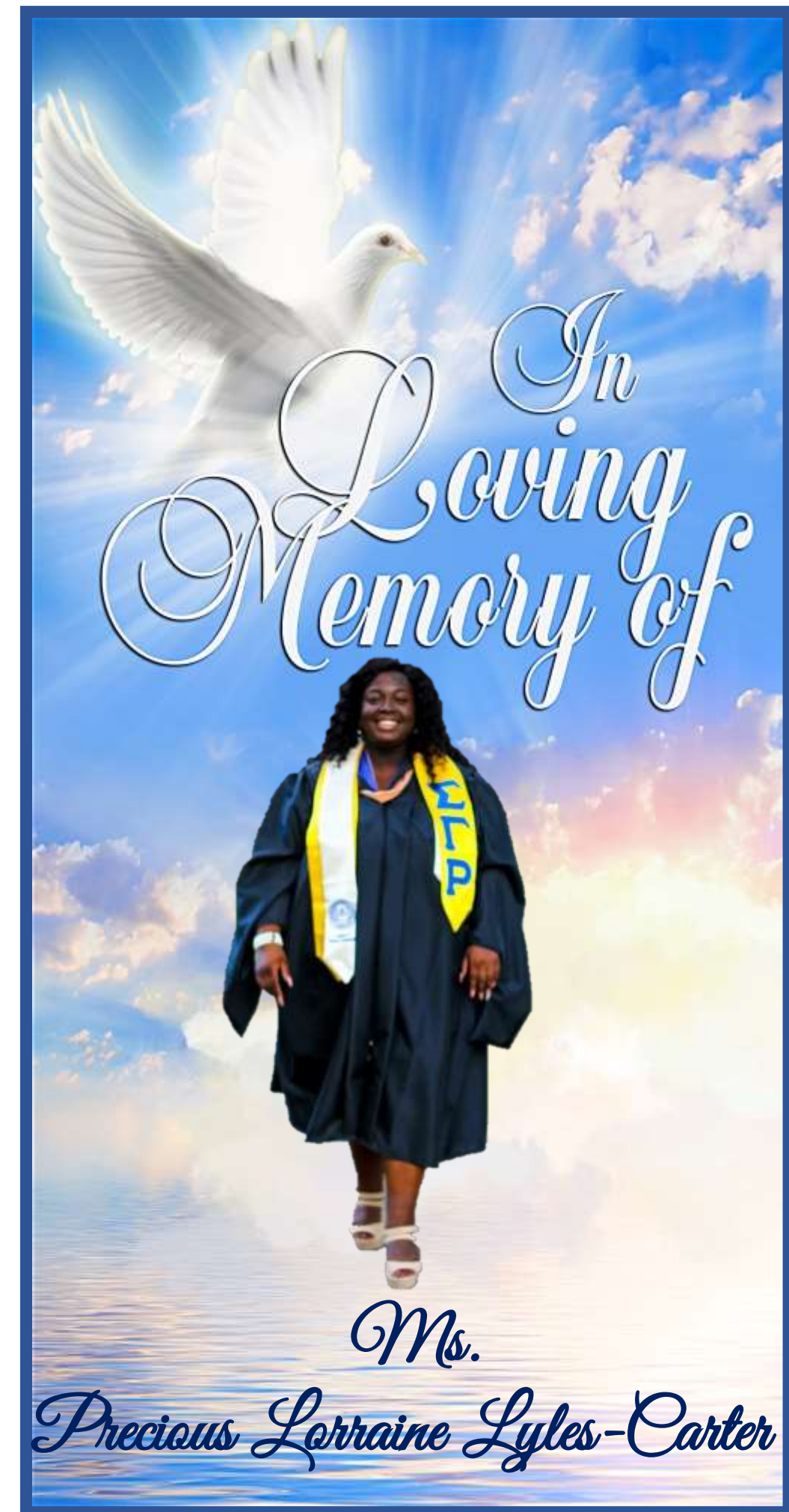

Obituary of Ms. Precious Lorraine Lyles Carter

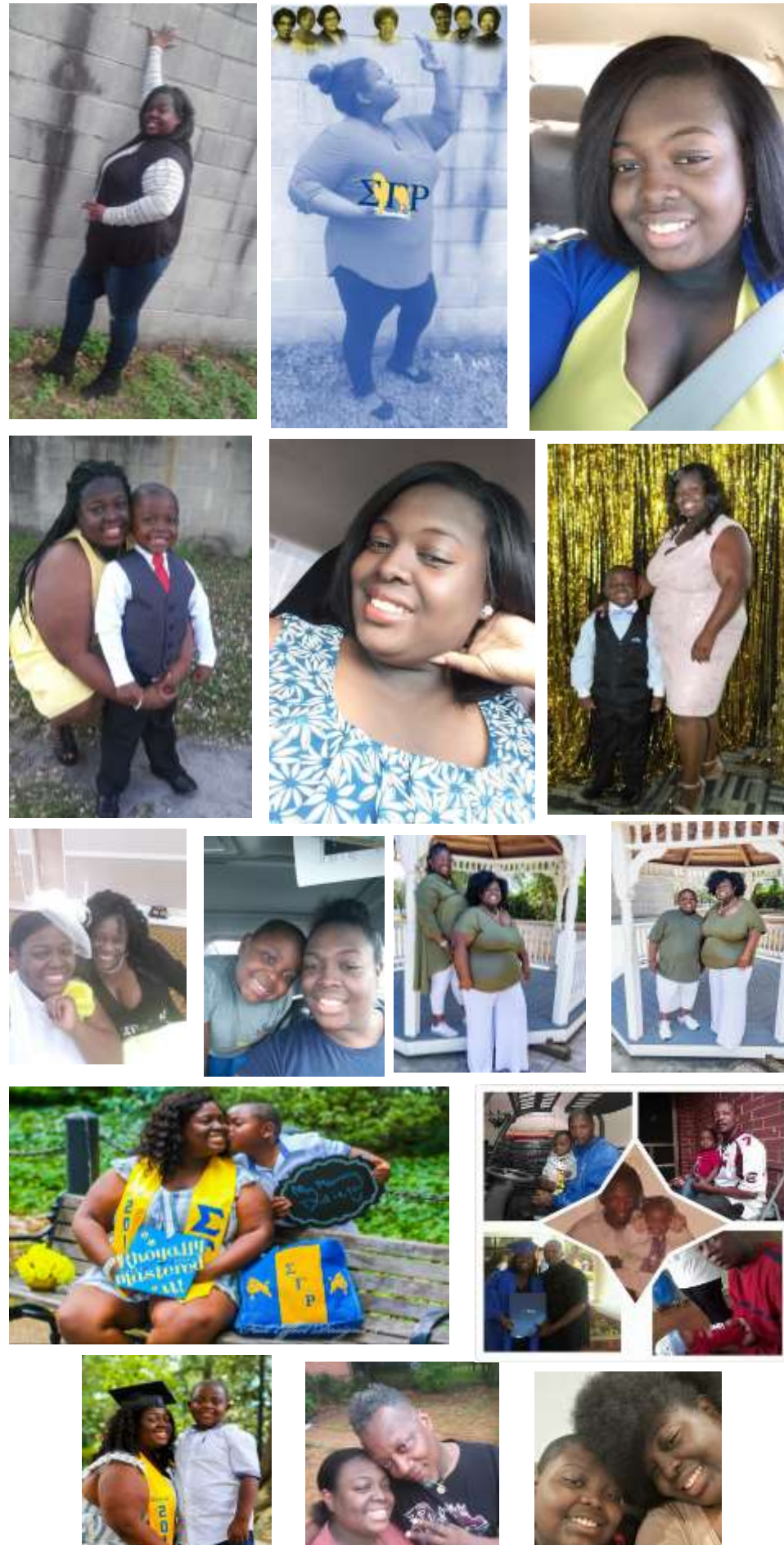
