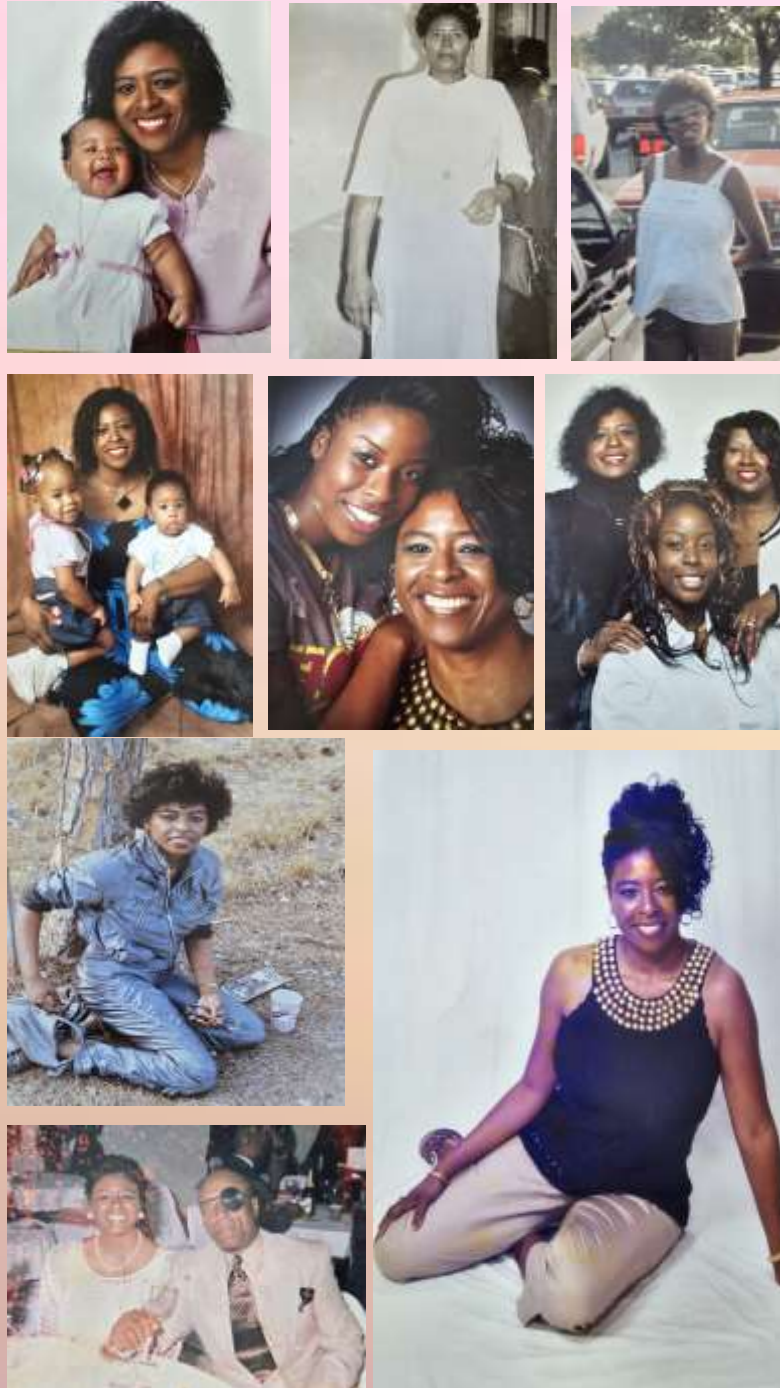
After returning to Columbia, she became a member of the New Ebenezer Baptist Church, where she served on the Dance Ministry.
