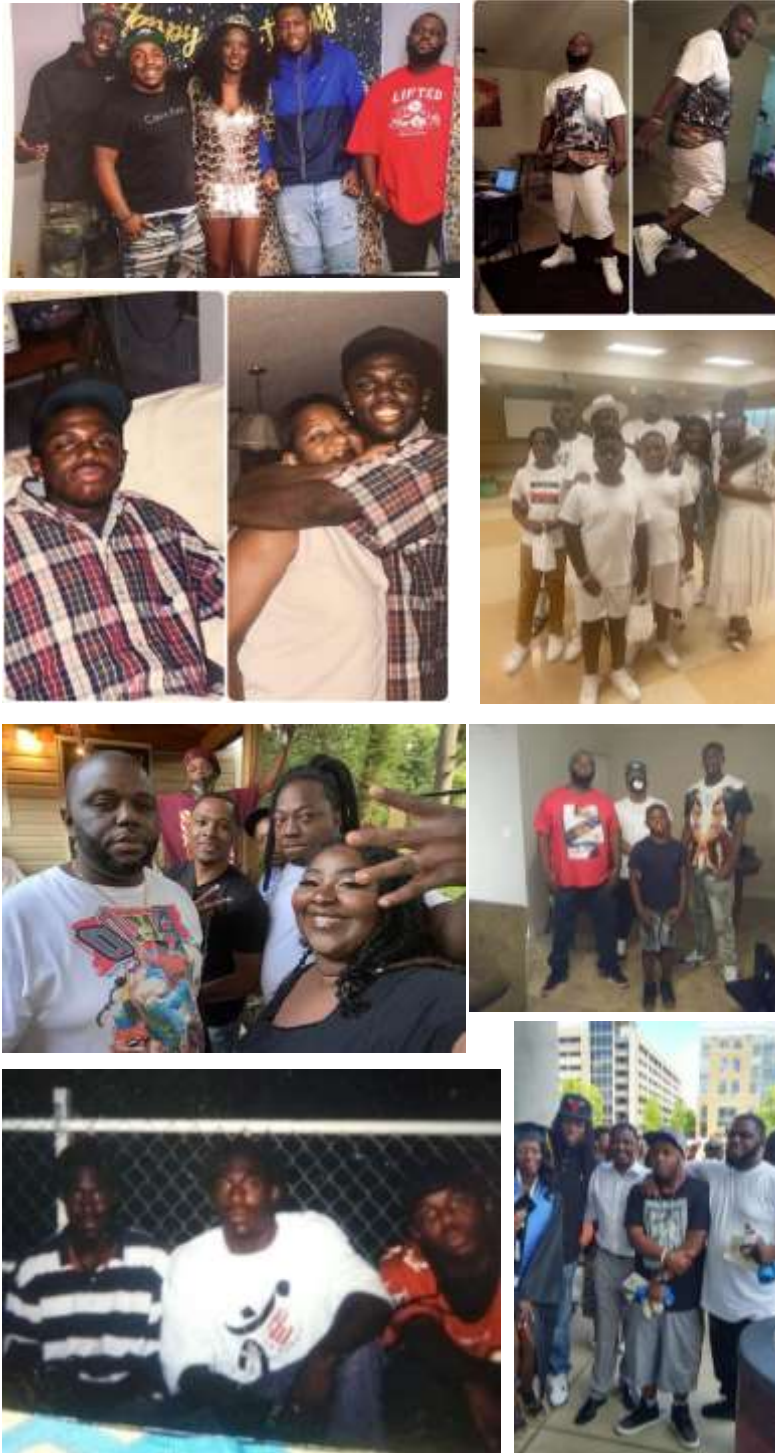
Daryl was educated in the public schools of Richland County, South Carolina. He was a loving and devoted father, son, and brother. Daryl was loved by all.
