Stacey attended Taylor Chapel AME Church and accepted Christ at an early age. He participated in many activities including being a member of the Young People’s Division.

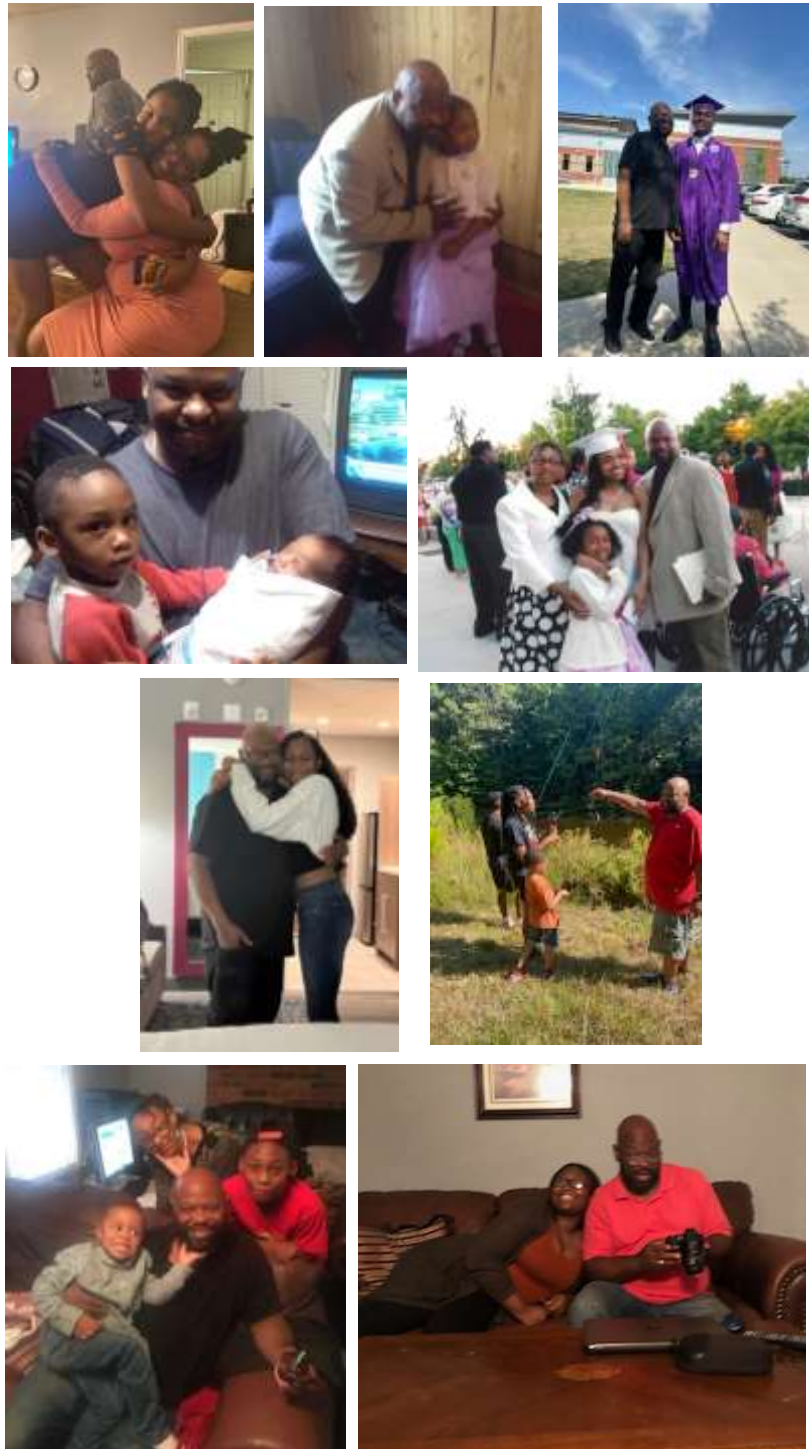
