Mr. Samuel Lee Felder*

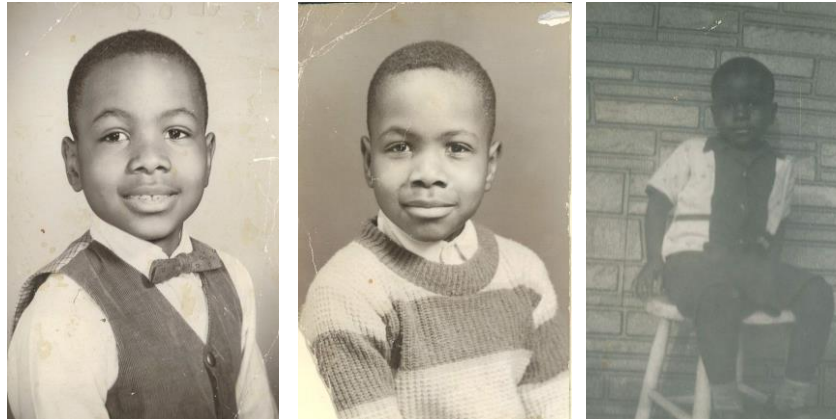

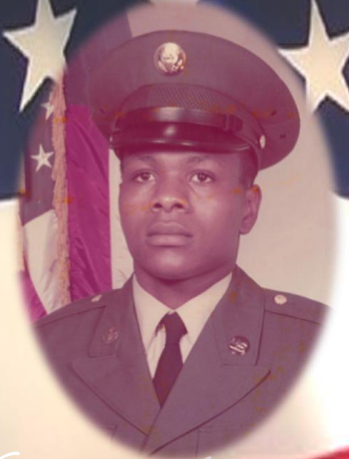
