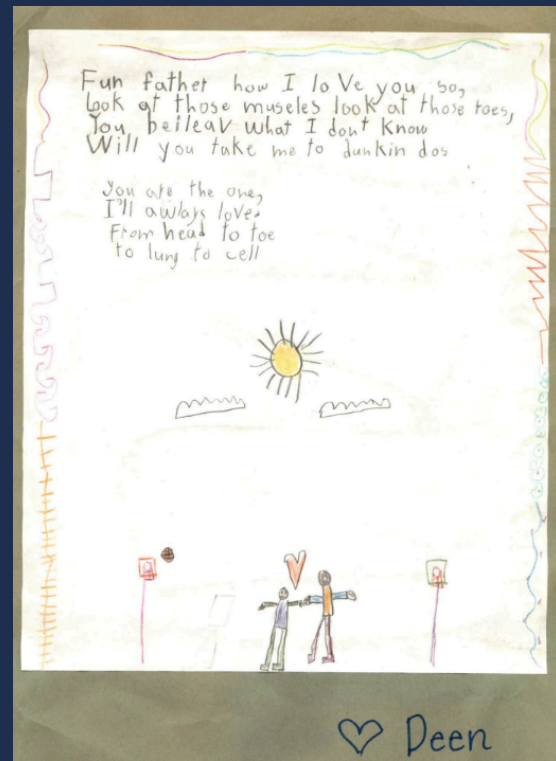

Dean Debrosse, age 52, passed away in Columbia, South Carolina, on July 15, 2024.

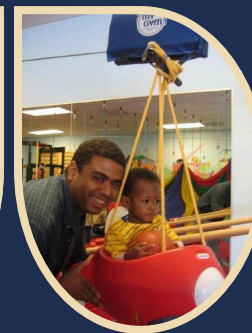
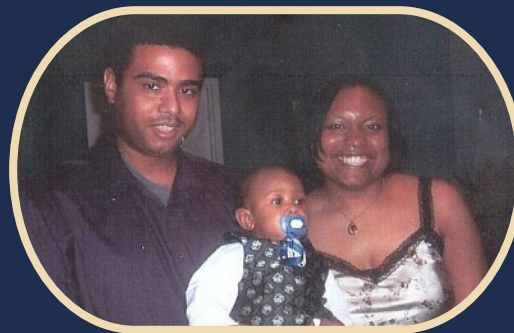
