## Mr. Earl Stanley Bennett, Jr.

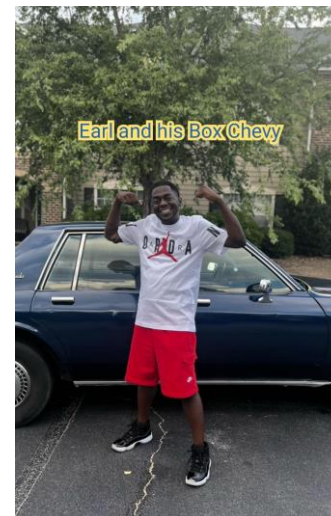
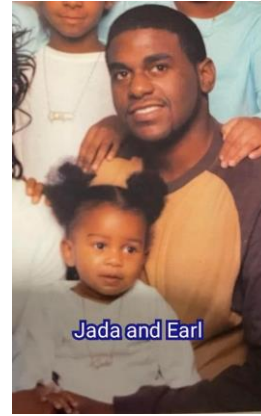
