At an early age, Marian accepted Christ as her personal Savior and became a member of Sandy Level Baptist Church, in Bethune, South Carolina.

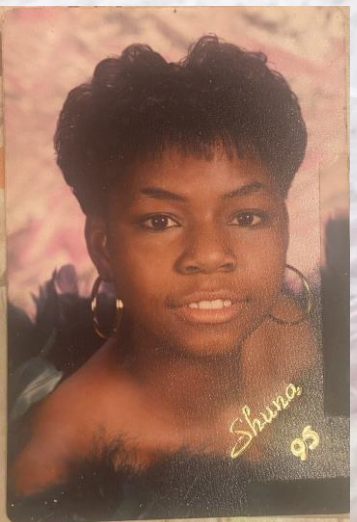
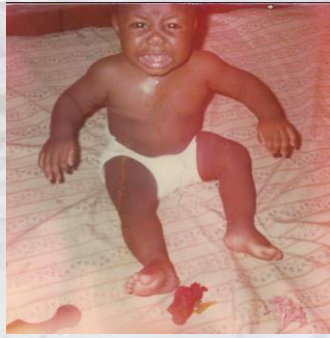
