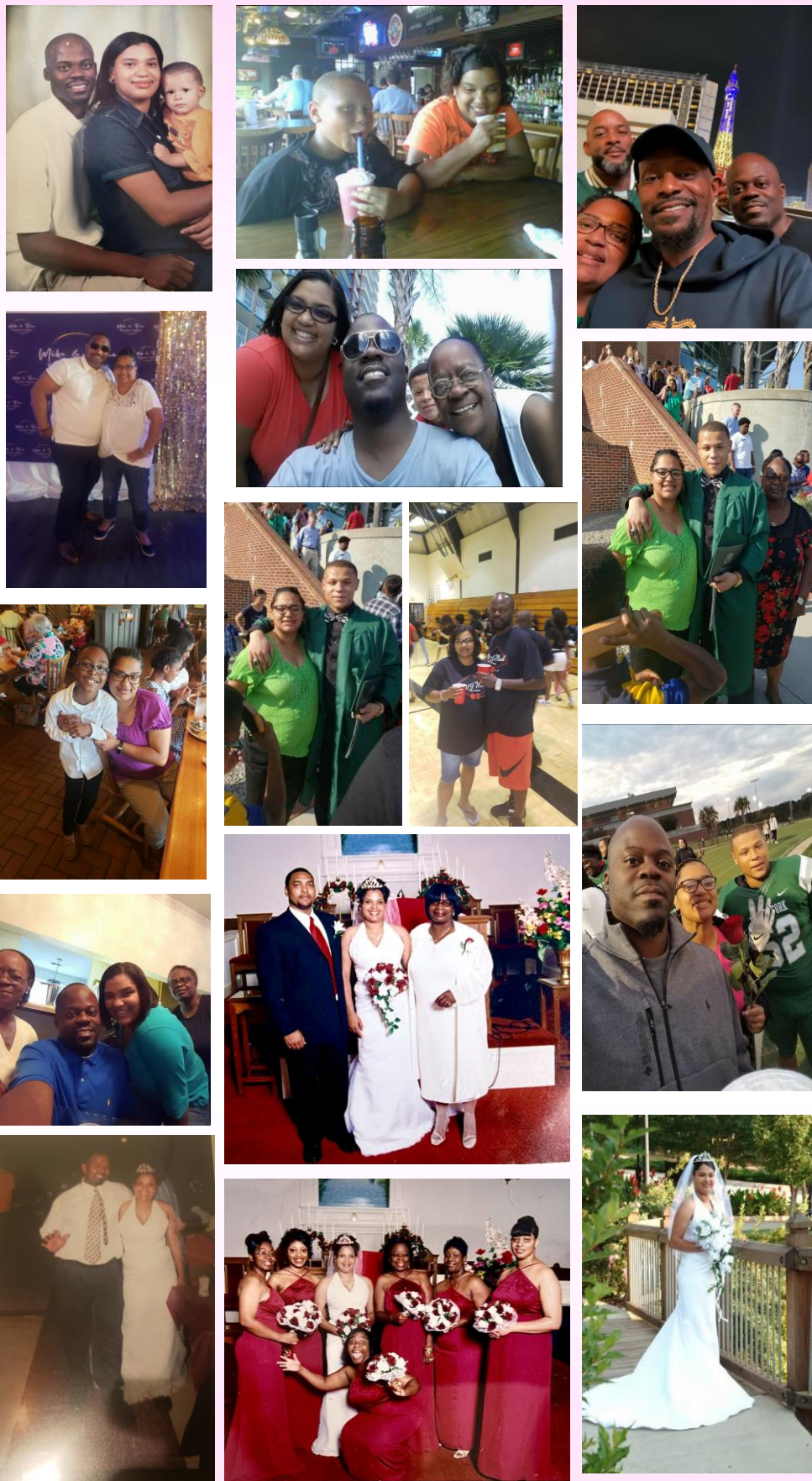
Obituary of Mrs. Tonja Denise Newton Jimerson
