He leads me beside still waters.

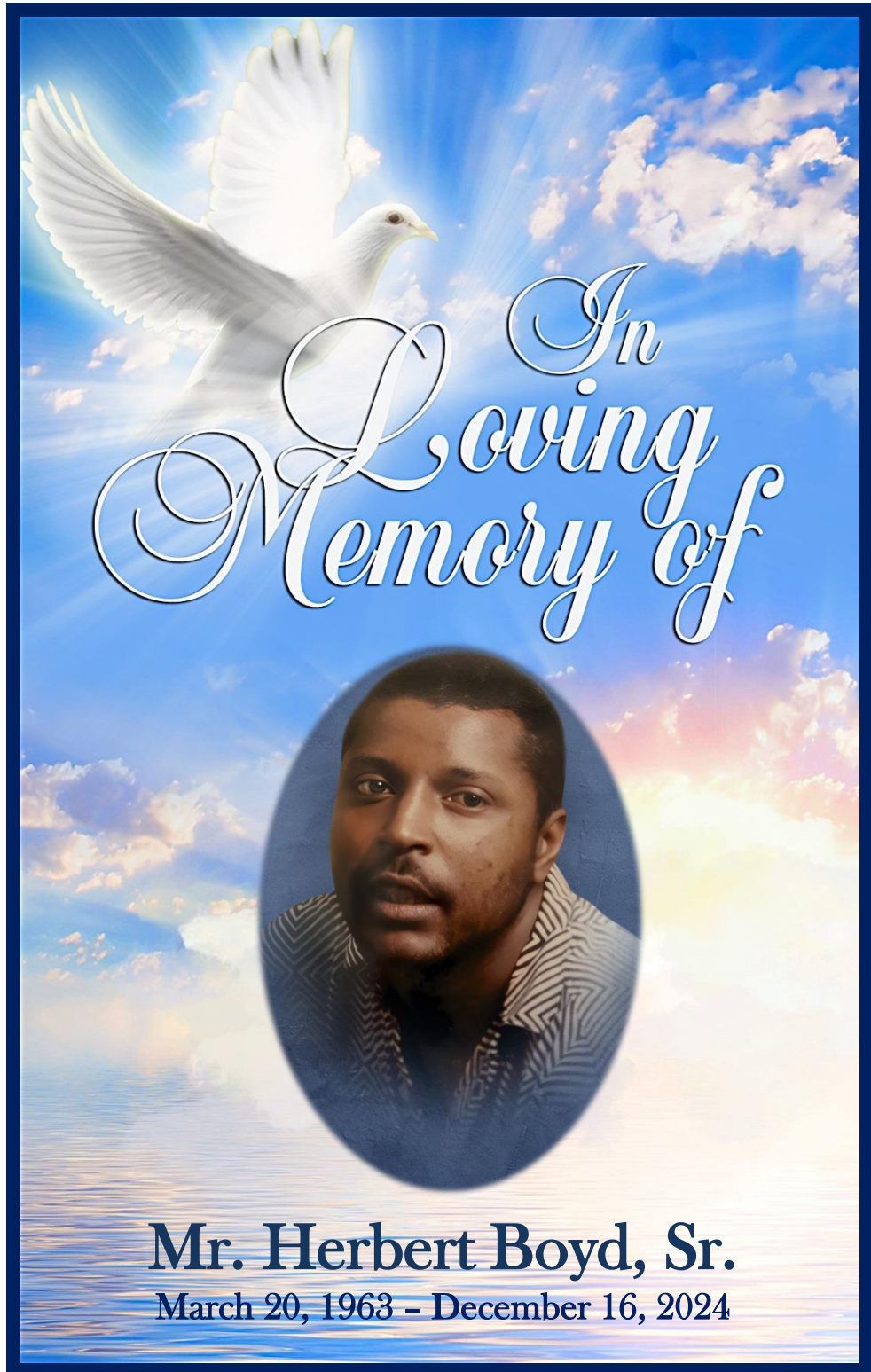
He restores my soul.
