Obituary of Deacon Michael Crump

Michael was born on November 23, 1964, in Bronx, New York. He departed this life on December 25, 2024, Blythewood, South Carolina. He was the second child born to Moses Johnell Crump and Hannah Bell Griffin Crump.

Michael or “Mike C” as he was often called, received his education in the public schools of Bronx, New York. During his youth, he made friends easily and enjoyed playing outside, going to movies, attending after school programs, summer day camp, working in various jobs, and family vacations. Gifted with a natural intuition for people and things who was a genius at taking items apart and putting them together again. He was fiercely protective of family and friends and could always be counted on in any challenging situation. Being employed by the New York City Housing Authority for 33 years, he worked consistently until his retirement in 2020.

In 1985, Michael enlisted in the United States Army and served three (3) years active duty at Fort Sills, Oklahoma. After completing his military service, he was honorably discharged from the Army.

In 1988, he met the love of his life Dunia (Dee Dee) Durand. Michael and Dunia would eventually officially be joined in Holy Matrimony. To that union, a daughter, Kiera I. Crump was born.

Michael and Dee Dee created a loving, secure and stable home life for their family in New York City for decades. They were hardworking and spent time with loved ones during holidays, vacations, and family reunions. He was a generous soul with a true love of life; possessed a big heart and an infectious welcoming smile. In terms of recreation, Michael enjoyed grilling (at **any** time of the year), driving, spending joyous time with family, friends, and attending church.

Michael devoted many years of his adult life to serving God and was an active member of the Little Mt. Calvary Miracle Church, Bronx, New York. Because of his dedication and willingness to serve, he was elevated and ordained to the role of Deacon in 2012.

In 2020, the family relocated to South Carolina to fully enjoy retirement from years of work and service in New York City. They created a loving family home and joined Macedonia Baptist Church (MBC).
