Mr. Sammy Leon Trapp

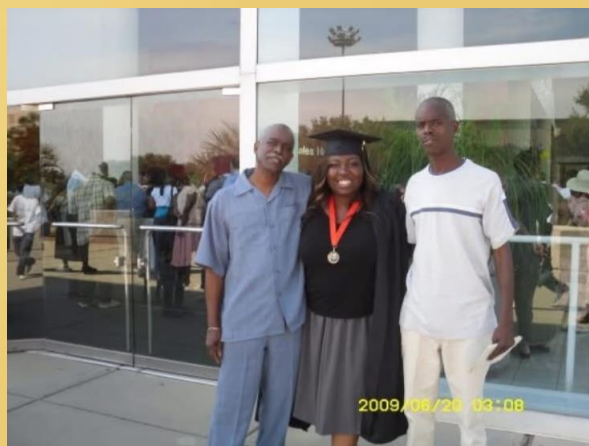
