Obituary of Mr. Derrick Khalil Mosby

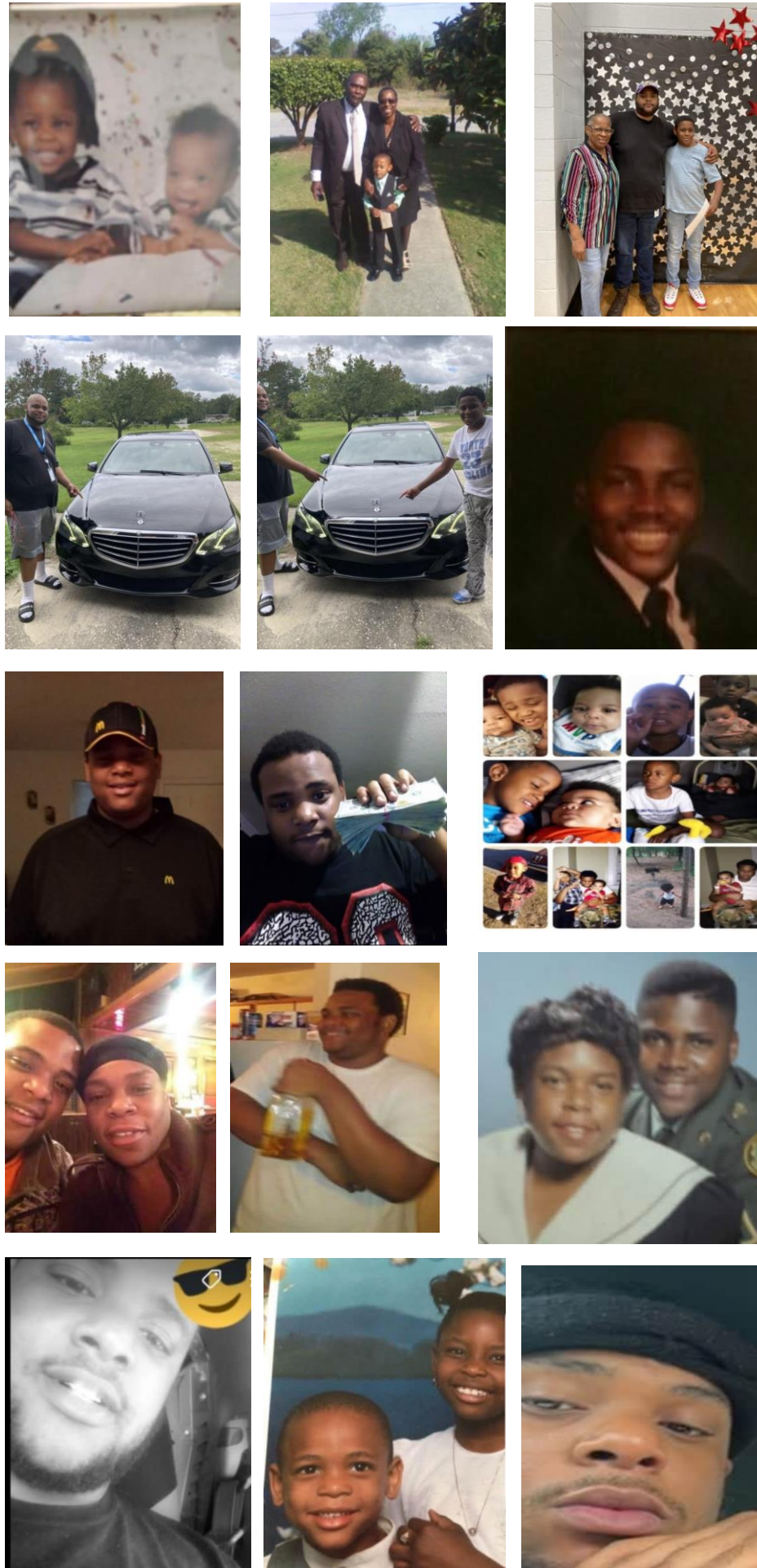
