

Obituary

Mr. Paul Allen Greene was born in Mooresville, North Carolina on August 17, 1938, to Otha and Madge P. Greene. He was the youngest son of 11 children. Paul was born into the Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church and knew the Lord Jesus Christ at an early age. He was educated in the Durham County school system graduating from Merrick-Moore High School in June 1958.

Paul joined the US Army Reserves in 1958 and served until 1962. In 1964, Paul married Christine Williams and to this union three children were born Justina, Pauletta and Sonya Greene. Paul and Christine moved to Brooklyn, NY in 1964; where he became interested early in computers at the dawn of the age and learned DOS and O/S Operation & Techniques. In 1966, he graduated from AmTec Training Center in New York for computer operations. He obtained employment with Electronic Data Systems (EDS) in Manhattan, NY and later relocated his job and family to Columbia, SC in 1972. Paul joined the North Columbia Baptist Church and served as a Sunday school bus driver and usher board member and was a member until his passing.

Paul worked for many years in the computer and banking industries, obtaining respective positions as manager and supervisor for C&S Bank, Policy Management System (PMS) and would later retire from Lockheed-Martin in 2008. He enjoyed his life and was an avid bowler for C&S Bank System Action League from 1977-1989 and Thursday Night Twilights 1990-1997. He was a dedicated and faithful member for nearly 50 years to the Free and Accepted Masonic Order; Prince Hall Affiliated-Morelight Lodge #468, C.C Johnson Consistory #136 and Cairo Shriner's Temple #125.

Paul's last request was to depart this world while living at home. On November 7, 2025; our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, shined upon him one last time and granted his prayer.

He leaves to cherish his memory: his brother, Charlie Greene (Mooresville, NC); children, Justina Greene (Woodbridge, Va), Pauletta Greene (Taylor, Mi.) and Sonya "Nickey" Greene (Detroit, MI); two grandchildren, Christina and Jacob Greene and a host of relatives, nieces, nephew and close family friends.
